ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE GRAND COUNCIL FOR MONTANA, UTAH AND IDAHO OF THE ORDER OF UNITED COMMERCIAL TRAVELERS OF AMERICA.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That pursuant to Chapter 14 of Title 15 of the Revised Codes of Montana of 1947, as amended, we, the undersigned, the Grand Counselor and Grand Secretary, the duly elected, qualified, installed and authorized presiding officer and secretary of the Grand Council for Montana, Utah and Idaho of the Order of United Commercial Travelers of America, under its existing Constitution and By-Laws, do voluntarialy associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Montana, and we hereby certify to-wit:

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is "THE GRAND COUNCIL FOR MONTANA, UTAH AND IDAHO OF THE ORDER OF UNITED COMMERCIAL TRAVELERS OF AMERICA", which is the name of the existing unincorporated association being incorporated.

SECOND: That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- (A). To give moral and material aid and assistance in its power to the local councils under its jurisdiction and to elevate the moral and social standing of the members of the said local councils under its jurisdiction.
 - (B). To unite the said local councils under its jurisdiction for the promotion and furtherence of the fraternal and benevolent ideals and principals of the Order

and to afford the said local councils under its jurisdiction, unity, support, assistance and supervision for the benefit of such local councils and the members thereof; and to afford to the said local councils under its jurisdiction and the members thereof representation to the Supreme Council of the Order.

- (C). To unite fraternally all Commercial

 Travelers and such other persons as may
 from time to time be deemed eligible to
 membership in the Order of United Commercial Travelers of America.
- (D). To give all mortal and material aid in its power to its members and all those dependent upon them; and to assist, if possible, the widows and orphans of deceased members.
- (E). To secure just and equitable favors for Commercial Travelers, Wholesalemen and other members.
- (F). To inculcate in its members and in the local councils under its jurisdiction and the members thereof and to promote generally the ideals and principles of Charity, Fellowship, Patriotism and Justice.
- (G). And for such other purposes as may be necessary for it to carry out its functions as a Grand Council of the Order of United Commercial Travelers of America.
- (H). To do all acts and things and business in any manner connected with the objects or purposes or powers of the corporation or necessary or incident thereto or auxillary thereto, and to directly or indirectly promote the interests, objectives and ideals of the Order, and in addition to have and to exercise all rights, powers and privileges

now or hereafter belonging to or conferred upon non-profit corporations existing under the laws of the State of Montana.

THIRD: This corporation is organized exclusively as a fraternal, benevolent and non-profit corporation, and its activities shall be conducted for the aforesaid purposes, and that it is a corporation which does not have as an object, nor does it contemplate, pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof, the local councils under its jurisdiction or the members thereof, and it is incorporated with all the powers by the laws of the State of Montana upon it conferred and allowed, including but not restricted to the following, to-wit:

- (A). To sue and be sued;
- (B). To contract and be contracted with;
- (C). To receive property by devise or bequest, subject to the laws regulating the transfer of property, real or personal, including shares of stock, bonds and securities of other corporations;
- (D). To act as trustee under any trust incidental to the principal objects of the corporation, and to receive, hold, administer, and expend funds and property subject to such trust;
- (E). To convey, exchange, lease, mortgage, encumber, transfer upon trust, or otherwise dispose of all property, real or personal;
- (F). To borrow money, contract debts, and issue bonds, notes and debentures, and to secure the same;
- (G). To do all other acts necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs and attainment of the purpose of this corporation;
- (H). To have and use a corporate seal.

EIFTH: The number and qualifications of its members, who shall be natural persons, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of each class of membership, if any, and the liabilities of each or all classes, the dues or assessments and the method of collection thereof will and shall be set forth in the By-Laws of this corporation and the Constitution and By-Laws governing the Supreme, Grand and Local Councils of the Order of United Commercial Travelers of America.

SIXTH: The officers, directors and trustee of this corporation, their nominations, qualifications, election or appointment, installation, powers and authority shall be in accordance with the provisions of the By-Laws of this corporation and the Constitution and By-Laws governing the Supreme, Grand and Local Councils of the Order of United Commercial Travelers of America.

SEVENTII: That the body which is to act in the capacity of
the Board of Directors of this corporation and which shall be subject
to all of the laws of the State of Montana relating to directors
shall be known as the "Executive Committee" and shall consist of
the following seven (7) members, to-wit: The Grand Counselor,
The Grand Secretary, The Grand Treasurer and four (4) other members
of the Grand Council.

NINTH: That the By-Laws of this corporation shall define the duties of the directors, officers and trustees of this corporation; the manner of election and the term of office of the directors, officers and trustees of this corporation shall be as set forth in the By-Laws of this corporation.

TENTH: The term for which this corporation is to exist shall be perpetual.

ELEVENTH: The members of this corporation may delegate to its Executive Committee any right or privilege which the members themselves have or shall hereafter have under the laws of the State of Montana, the By-Laws of this corporation or the Constitution and By-Laws of this Order governing the Supreme, Grand and Local Councils of the Order of United Commercial Travelers of America, including the right to change from time to time the principal place of business of this corporation.
