# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF KIRST BAPTIST CHURCH, WEISER INC.

DONART & DONART ATTORNEYS AT LAW Weiser, Idaho KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, Dale Thomason, M. J. Johnson, Hattie Carson, Robert Vogel and Mary Cheadle, all of Weiser, Idaho and each of whom is a resident and citizen of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, providing for the incorporation of religious, social and benevolent corporations, and for such purpose to hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

#### ARTICLE I

The name of this Corporation shall be the "First Baptist Church of Weiser."

#### ARTICLE II

This association is not formed for pecuniary profit, but is formed to promote religious, social and benevolent thought and action, under the rules, regulations and discipline of said Church, and to purchase, hold, mortgage and sell such land and personal property as may be necessary to carry out such purposes.

### ARTICLE III

That heretofore on the 15th day of November, 1959, at the hour of one o'clock P. M., of said day, a meeting of the members of said Church was held at the First Baptist Church in the City of Weiser, County of Washington, State of Idaho, at which meeting a majority of its members were present and voted, and an election for five (5) directors was held; that prior to said meeting notice of the time and place of holding such meeting was given by publication for two weeks in the Weiser merican a newspaper published at Weiser and of general circulation in Weiser, Idaho; that at such election five (5) directors were elected for said Church with authority to incorporate said Church and at which election the following named directors were elected for the ensuing year, to-wit:
