



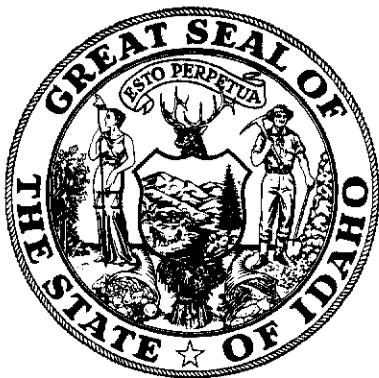
CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

The number of Directors constituting its initial Board of Directors is one (1), whose names and addresses are:


