

AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR THE FIRST PRESBYTER-
IAN CHURCH OF MOSCOW, IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:- THAT, whereas the Articles of Incorporation of the First Presbyterian Church of Moscow, Idaho, filed with the Secretary of State, then Territory of Idaho, on the 5th day of November A.D. 1888, and with the Recorder of the County of Nez Perce now Latah, said state on the 23rd. day of December 1889, and by which said church as a corporation has since been governed are not in compliance with the requirements of the present law of this state in relation to organization of religious corporations; and whereas, said Articles in some important particulars are ineffectual for, and unsuited and inadequate to the present needs of said church and corporation and should be supplemented and amended; Therefore, we, the undersigned Trustees of the First Presbyterian Church of Moscow, Idaho, residents and citizens of said state, for and on behalf of, and in compliance with, and by the authority of the vote of a majority of the members thereof as appears herein, do hereby make, adopt and certify the following amended Articles of Incorporation:-

1st. The name of this Corporation is The First Presbyterian Church of Moscow, Idaho.

2nd. This corporation is formed for the purpose of conducting and maintaining the preaching of the Gospel, and religious services in accordance with the mode of worship known and authorized by the Presbyterian Church of ^{The U.S. of} America, and according to the rules, regulations and discipline, and the Confession of Faith as adopted and sanctioned by the General Assembly of said Church.

3rd. This Corporation is not formed for pecuniary purposes whatever

4th. The place where the principal business of this Corporation is to be transacted is the City of Moscow, State of Idaho.

5th. The members of this Corporation shall consist of members of the local church aforesaid, as shown by the membership record thereof.

6th. ^{After the first year under these Amended Articles} the number of Trustees shall be six, all of whom shall be members of and elected by the local church, said Board of Trustees shall annually elect from its members a President, Vice President and Secretary these officers, together with a Treasurer and such other officers as

may be provided for in the By-laws of this corporation shall constitute the officers of the Corporation; Provided, that after the first year under the amended Articles of Incorporation the term of office of each trustee and the number to be annually elected shall be set forth in the By-laws; and provided further that the office of Treasurer and of Secretary may be held by one and the same person, the treasurer may or may not be a member of the Board of Trustees as the Corporation may think best; and provided further that except the President, Vice President and Secretary all of the aforesaid officers shall be elected by the members of the Corporation; Provided that when the offices of Secretary and Treasurer are held by one and the same person then the Board of Trustees shall elect the Secretary-Treasurer.

7th. All property now held, or which may be acquired by gift, purchase or otherwise by this corporation, and the proceeds therefrom shall be used exclusively for church purposes, and in accordance with the usage, custom, doctrine and discipline of the Presbyterian Church of ^{The U.S. of} America as approved and authorized by the General Assembly thereof.

8th. The general religious interests, welfare and oversight of this corporation shall be under the direction and control of the General Assembly of the Church, the Synod and Presbytery within which this corporation performs its chief transactions, and immediately under the supervision and control of the pastor and session; but the property of whatever name and nature and however acquired belonging to the corporation shall be managed, controlled and transferred by the Board of Trustees according to the laws of this state, the rules and regulations of the church and the provisions of the By-laws relating thereto.

9th. The following persons shall constitute the Board of Trustees for the first year under the Amended Articles of Incorporation, and until their successors are elected or appointed, to-wit; F.A. David, Oscar Mc Carter, C.H. Patten, S.A. Boyd, H.M. Sawrtwood ~~and Henry Engelsen~~, for the election of whom there was held at the First Presbyterian Church of Moscow, Idaho, on the 28th. day of April an election at which a majority of the church members and members of the corporation were present and voted, and the aforesaid named persons, members of the said church and corporation were duly elected to serve as Trustees of this corporation

for the first year under the Amended Articles of Incorporation and un-
their successors are elected or appointed as the case may be. At the
same time and place by a unanimous vote of the members aforesaid the
following resolution was passed, to-wit; " Be it resolved that F.A. David
Oscar Mc Carter, C.H. Patten, S.A. Boyd, H.M. Swartwood and Henry Erickson
the duly elected trustees of the corporation for the ensuing year forth-

for the better government of this corporation" and for the election afoer
said and the passing of the said resolution F.A. David and J.R. Hall
acted as officers of said election and meeting.

the Articles of Incorporated now of record as hereinbefore set forth.




