ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
CONNOLLY AND KROETCH.

Be it known that we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho,

And we certify:

First. That the name of said incorporation is: Connolly and Kroetch.

Second. That the purposes for which it is formed are: To carry on a general lumber and logging business; to manufacture, buy and sell lumber, logs, mining timbers, poles, posts, and all timber products; to own, buy and sell land; to own, buy and sell timber, timber products and timber lands; to do contract work in logging and loading; to buy and sell mining stock in connection with the said business; to loan money in connection with the said business; to engage in mercantile pursuits in connection with the said business; and to do all things necessary in the operation of said business.

Third. That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be Harrison, County of Kootenai, State of Idaho.

Fourth. That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

Fifth. That the number of directors shall be three, and that
for the first year
the names and residences of those who are appointed/are as follows:

L. F. Connolly, Harrison, Idaho.
Joseph J. Kroetch, Harrison, Idaho.
John N. Wilson, Spokane, Washington.

Sixth. That the amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be Forty-five thousand dollars (\$45000.00), divided into Four Hundred and Fifty shares, of the par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each.

Seventh. That the amount of said capital stock that has been actually subscribed is Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45000.00), and the following are the names of the persons by whom the same has been subscribed, to-wit:
