

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

FRANKLIN COUNTY ASSOCIATION
FOR RETARDED CITIZENS, INC.

ARTICLE 1

NAME

The name of the organization shall be Franklin County Association for Retarded Citizens, Inc. The term "retarded citizen" as used herein shall include all mentally retarded persons and persons with other handicaps or learning disabilities regardless of age, degree, type of retardation and regardless of whether or not they attend public, private, or religious schools, residential or day school, or whether they reside at home or in institutions.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE

Section 1:

The purposes of the Association are:

- a. To promote the general welfare of the mentally retarded wherever they may be.
- b. To foster the development of programs in their behalf.
- c. To encourage research related to mental retardation.
- d. To advise and aid parents in the solution of their problems and to coordinate their efforts and activities.

- e. To develop a better understanding of the problems of mental retardation by the public.
- f. To cooperate with all public, private and religious agencies and professional groups to the furtherance of these ends.
- g. To serve locally as a clearinghouse for gathering and giving out information regarding the mentally retarded.
- h. To solicit and receive funds for the accomplishment of the above purposes.

Section 2:

This Association is a non-profit, non-political, non-secretarian organization. No part of any net earnings shall insure to the benefit of any member or individual, and no officer or director of the Association shall receive any compensation for his services as an officer or director.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP

Membership shall be open to all parents, relatives, and guardians, including foster parents, of retarded citizens and to other persons sympathetic to the purposes of the Association.

ARTICLE IV

OFFICERS

The officers shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary, and a Treasurer. There shall be not less than four and not more than twelve directors. No employee of

the Association may serve as an officer or director. The officers are as follows:

ARTICLE V

AREA OF ACTIVITY

The area which the Association intends to serve includes Franklin County, Idaho.

ARTICLE VI

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VIII

VOTING

This Corporation is organized without capital stock. The voting power and property rights and interest of the members of this corporation shall be equal to one vote per member.

ARTICLE IX

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The management of all the affairs, property and

interest of the corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors as provided for in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE X

DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively as a business league under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Under no circumstances shall any of the property or assets of this corporation during the existence and/or upon the dissolution thereof go to or be distributed to any officer, member or subsidiary of this corporation.

ARTICLE XI

AMENDMENTS

Any proposed amendment, along with the date it is to be voted upon, shall be presented in writing to the entire general membership at least three (3) weeks prior to the meeting at which it is to be voted upon and two-thirds (2/3) vote of those in attendance required for ratification.

This is the current constitution, revised, approved, and adopted by the membership on October 1st, 1984.
