ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION SUBLETT IRRIGATION COMPANY

The undersigned incorporators and directors of Sublett Irrigation Company submit the following Restated and Amended Articles of Incorporation to the Secretary of State, State of Idaho:

RESTATED ARTICLE 1

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Sublett Irrigation Company.

RESTATED ARTICLE 2

NONPROFIT

The corporation is organized as a nonprofit corporation pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho.

RESTATED ARTICLE 3

DURATION

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

RESTATED ARTICLE 4

PURPOSES

The corporation is organized for the following purposes:

To acquire, own, hold, buy, sell, develop, file upon, procure by appropriation or otherwise, water, water rights, springs, artesian wells or other sources of water

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supply; to drill for water, or to develop natural springs or other sources of water supply.

- To acquire, own, hold, build, construct, maintain, operate reservoirs, dams, head gates, and diversion works, conduits, pipe lines, ditches, flumes, hydrants, wells or other apparatus for storing, impounding, conveying, distributing and supplying water to stockholders for domestic, culinary and irrigation purposes, at actual cost and without pecuniary profit, and to that end to construct reservoirs, dams, head gates, measuring devices and diversion works, ditches, and other conduits and to distribute water to the respective stockholders.
- To sell, rent and distribute water to stockholders.
- To buy, own, hold, contract for, lease, rent, sell, convey, develop, improve, mortgage, incumber or otherwise handle, transfer or operate real estate, improvements upon real estate, buildings necessary or otherwise for operating and maintaining the business and affairs of this corporation.
- To borrow money and execute its promissory notes, bills of exchange, drafts or other negotiable instruments therefor, and to secure the same by mortgages, trust deeds, debentures or other incumbrances upon the property of this corporation. To loan money, to issue bonds and sell the same, to purchase or retire bonds, to own, hold, buy, sell, mortgage,

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lease, hypothecase or otherwise dispose of shares of the capital stock of this corporation, or any other corporation.

- To make all necessary rules, regulations and provisions for the operation and maintenance of reservoirs, irrigation systems, head gates, ditches, conduits, and for distributing the water to stockholders of this corporation, and to collect rentals, tolls, or dues therefor, sufficient to defray the expenses of maintaining, operating and distributing the waters belonging to this corporation to the respective stockholders without profit.
- To do all things necessary to be done in properly procuring, developing, drilling for, storing and distributing water; constructing, maintaining reservoirs and diversion works, and collecting rentals therefor, not, however, for pecuniary profit, but for the actual cost and expense of distributing, supplying water, and for operating, maintaining and repairing any such reservoirs, storage works or distributing systems, or other property belonging to the corporation.
- Any other lawful purpose of a nonprofit corporation allowed by the laws of the State of Idaho.

AMENDED ARTICLE 8

VOTING RIGHTS

Stockholders shall not be entitled to cumulate votes. At each election for directors every shareholder entitled to vote at such election shall have the right to vote, in person or by proxy, the number of shares owned by him for as many persons as there are directors to be elected.

It was further resolved that the incorporators, officers and directors take such action as is necessary in order to file the Restated and Amended Articles of Incorporation with the Secretary of State.
