CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, FRED E. LUKENS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

KILLOGG CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **first** day of **February** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **and thirty** and is duly recorded in Book **1-25** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 3 of Chapter 262 of the 1929 Session Laws of Idaho, and Sections 4865 to 4869, inclusive, Idaho Compiled Statutes.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for a term of **fifty years** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Killogg** in the County of **Shoshone**, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations, as provided in Chapter 195, Idaho Compiled Statutes.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of the
KELLOGG CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the United States and one of whom is a bona fide resident of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby certify in writing:

I.

That the name of this corporation shall be KELLOGG CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.

II.

That the object and purpose of this organization shall be the up-building of the City of Kellogg, the County of Shoshone, and the State of Idaho, encouraging and assisting all public improvements of all kinds therein, including streets, highways, sewers, public buildings, and any and all things which are for the public good; assisting in locating schools and colleges, libraries, and all things which look toward higher and better educational advantages; locating and developing and assisting in the location and development therein of manufactures, mining enterprises, and other industries; buying, owning, developing, and selling property, real and personal, borrowing money and issuing bonds and other evidences of indebtedness and executing mortgages or deeds of trust to secure the same; assisting in the conducting of a merchants' association which will bring merchants and parties engaged in trade in closer association and work; assisting in the conducting of a board of trade with all the necessary adjuncts which shall unite under rules of business and justice and which are not contrary to law, the business of buying, selling, and exchanging commodities and for the conduct of all lines of business; for organizing and conducting any other bureau or bureaus or exchanges which the members shall deem beneficial in building up said City, County, and State, and for the business interests thereof and of this organization. Said organization shall have full power to do any and all things deemed necessary in carrying on any and all of the above objects to foster, promote, and advance the commercial industries, civic, physical, and moral development of the City of Kellogg and vicinities; provided, that no act shall be done by this organization directly or indirectly fixing the price or regulating the production of any article of commerce or produce or of consumption by the people.

III.

The principal place of business shall be at Kellogg in the County of Shoshone, State of Idaho

IV.

The term for which this corporation shall exist is fifty (50) years from the date of its incorporation, unless sooner dissolved as provided by law.

V.

In this association the rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member.

Pecuniary profit is not the object of this corporation, said corporation being organized under Chapter 195 of the Idaho Compiled Statutes and laws and acts supplementary thereto and amendatory thereof. There is no capital stock and no subscribers for any stock, and the undersigned are the incorporators and constitute the present membership of said association until said association shall be incorporated and the said membership increased as provided by the by-laws to be adopted by said association and the laws of the State of Idaho.
