

Articles of Incorporation of the "Spokane
Port Dahl and Eastern Rail Road and
Navigation Co."

I) Know all men by these
Present: That we the undersigned have
this day voluntarily associated ourselves
together for the purpose of forming a
Corporation under the laws of the
Territory of Idaho. And we do hereby certify;
First, That the name of said Corporation
is the "Spokane, Port Dahl and Eastern Rail
Road and Navigation Co."

Second—That the purposes for which it
is formed are to build and equip a main
line of Rail Road and necessary branches
and to build and run Steamboats, for
the carrying of freight and passengers
and to take up all the usual business
of Rail Roads and Steamboats in the Ter-
ritories of Washington Idaho and Montana
Third—That the place where its principal
business is to be transacted shall be the
Town of Port Dahl in Northen County
Idaho Territory.

Fourth—That the term for which it is
to exist is fifty years from and after
the date of its incorporation.

Fifth—That the number of its directors
shall be seven and the names and addresses
of those who are appointed for the first
year are

Ninth — That the amount of the Capital Stock of this Corporation shall be Five Million Dollars divided into Fifty thousand shares of One Hundred Dollars each

Tenth — That the amount of said Capital Stock which has been actually subscribed is Four Hundred Thousand Dollars, and the following are the names of the persons (or whos) whose name has been subscribed to it:

Eighth — That said Rail Road including all Bridges shall be built the standard gauge and shall be equipped and run in like manner as all first class Rail Roads in

Care passengers and freight.

With that said below line of Rail Road is to start at a point on some Rail Road east of the city of Spokane Falls in Washington Territory thence down the navigable water on Spokane River at Post Falls in Kootenai County Idaho Territory, thence to a point (or) or near Hayden Lake, thence by the most feasible route to steamboat landing on south end of lake and thence thence along the south shore of said lake to the mouth of Gold Creek thence following the shore of said lake to the mouth of Clark Fork, or by the easiest and best pass the Sheep Creek Fork thence up Clark Fork to Missoula Mountain with branch from mouth of Gold Creek to Chloride and Weber City thence across the divide to the Little French fork of Cowd' Aleve river thence down said Little French Fork to the mouth of the Cowd' Aleve river thence up the French Fork of said river to a point near the mouth of Eagle Creek thence up Eagle Creek to Murray in Bonneville County Idaho Territory. Also a branch from the town of Post Falls south to a point on Rock Creek in Rock Creek valley in Worthington Territory. Said main line of Rail Road to connect at Post Falls with Steamboat to

run up the Spokane river to Donal's
Milk Lake and to navigate said lake
and any and all of its tributaries
(Also to connect at Steamboat Landing on
Pend d'Orille lake with Steamboats to
navigate said lake and all of its trib-
utaries)
