AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name stated in the articles, and for a term of fifty years, and as such are entitled to all the rights and privileges granted to, and subject to the limitations of Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 196, Idaho Compiled Statutes.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE TWIN FALLS CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the members of the Congregational Church of Kimberly, Twin Falls County, Idaho, desire to form a corporation as provided for under Chapter 196 of the Idaho Compiled Statutes of 1919, and for that purpose do hereby adopt the following articles and do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I. Name.

The name by which said corporation shall be known is the Congregational Church of Twin Falls Idaho.

ARTICLE II. Purposes.

The purposes for which said corporation is to be formed are:

a. To acquire, hold, purchase, accept by gift or otherwise, title to real and personal property, to be used for church purposes.

b. To mortgage, grant by trust deed or otherwise sell property now owned or hereafter to be acquired, to raise money for erection of a church or other public building or buildings to be used for religious purposes in connection with said church or public building or buildings, and for the equipment and furnishing of same.

c. To provide for the management and control of said property, and the support and maintenance of the pastor or pastors, and to provide for him or them a house in which to live, and to do such other things as may be necessary and requisite for maintenance and carrying on of a church.

ARTICLE III. Term.

The term for which said corporation is to exist is fifty (50) years, and the principal place of business is Twin Falls, Idaho.

ARTICLE IV. Officers.

That the title of the persons making these articles is "Trustees", elected from among the members of the congregation who are members of said church and who shall have entire management and control of all property thereof, and shall be known as the "Board of Trustees", and are to be five in number.

ARTICLE V. ELECTION.

That on *Monday*, the *2nd* day of *January* A. D. 1928, at the hour of *10* o'clock *P.* M. of said day, in the building now occupied and used for church purposes and known as Jacob Hochhalter's Residence, in Kimberly, Twin Falls, County, Idaho, an election was called and held by the members of said church, at which time and place the undersigned trustees were duly elected by the members of said congregation as such trustees for said purposes.

ARTICLE VI.

That the notice of election was duly published in the Twin Falls Daily News, a daily newspaper printed and published at Twin Falls, Idaho, and of general circulation within said

county, for a period of two weeks prior to the holding of said election, and also by posting on the door of the church building at Twin Falls Idaho, the place of holding said meeting for the same period of time.

ARTICLE VII.

That the hereunto attached certificate is a certificate of the presiding officer of said meeting showing the result thereof, which said certificate is herewith referred to and made a part thereof.

That the name of the trustees so elected at such meeting are as follows:
