ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that We, the undersigned, at least one of whom is a bona fide resident of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves, and do hereby and by these Articles of Incorporation unite and associate ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho:

I.

The name of this corporation is TRADE DOLLAR LEASING COMPANY.

II.

The period of the existence of this corporation shall be fifty (50) years.

III.

The principal office and the place where the principal business of said corporation is to be transacted is at the City of Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho.

IV.

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

To lease, acquire, own, work, mortgage, sell and dispose of mines, mining grounds, lode or placer claims, mills, mill sites, tunnel sites, mining and mineral rights, and any interest therein, and to prospect, explore, work, locate, develop and turn to account the same.

To extract, crush, concentrate, reduce, amalgamate

and prepare for market ores, metals and mineral substances of all kinds and to carry on any other mining and metallurgical operations which may seem conducive to the company's objects.

To lease, buy, sell and deal in minerals, plants, mills, machinery, implements, conveniences, provisions and things capable of being used in connection with mining operations, or required by workmen and others employed by the company.

To construct, carry out, maintain, improve, manage, work, control and superintend any roads, ways, tramways, reservoirs, water courses, mills, crushing works and other works and conveniences which may be necessary directly or indirectly, in connection with any objects of the company.

V.

The business and affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a board of three (3) directors. The names and residences of the persons chosen directors to manage the business and affairs of said corporation for the first year are as follows:
