

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF
IDAHO METAL FINISHING, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the Business Corporation Act of Idaho, as set forth in Title 30, Idaho Code, Volume 5, do hereby certify as follows:

I.

The name of the corporation is IDAHO METAL FINISHING, INC..

II.

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(a) To buy, sell, own and deal in real estate, livestock, bonds, securities and other properties of all kinds on its own account and for commission, in the United States and elsewhere.

(b) To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire lands and buildings in this state or elsewhere for the erection and establishment of a manufactory or manufactories and workshops with suitable platin, engines, and machinery, and to manufacture, buy, sell, import and export, and otherwise deal in the manufacture of iron, steel, manganese, coke, copper, brass, lumber and other materials and all, or any, articles consisting or partly consisting of iron, steel, copper, wood or other materials, and all or any products thereof, including electroplating chrome, nickle, silver, gold, copper, etc. and the application of all types of chemical resisting finishes such as teflon, epoxy, silicone, etc; and the purchase and sale of goods, wares and merchandise used for such business.

(c) To contract for erection, construction, or repair of any building, structure or improvement, public or private, and erect, construct or repair same or any part thereof, and to acquire, own, prepare for use any materials for said purposes.

(d) To maintain and keep storage warehouses for the storage and deposit of goods and merchandise of all kinds and descriptions, and conduct all business appertaining thereto, including the making of advances on goods stored and deposited with it, and to have and receive all the rights and emoluments thereto belonging.

(e) To acquire farm properties and other real estate, by purchase, lease or otherwise, to improve and develop the same, and thereon to plant, sow, cultivate and harvest grains, hay, forage, vegetables, fruit and all kinds of farm produce and products of the soil; to breed, raise, buy, pasture, prepare for market, exhibit, sell, and deal in livestock of all kinds; to engage in dairying and the poultry business; to acquire and maintain vehicles, farm machinery and all other farm equipment suitable for farming; to act as broker, dealer, or commission merchant dealing in all kinds of farm produce, and in particular, potatoes; and in general, to conduct the business of farmers, dairymen, stock raisers, and poultry raisers, and to do everything incidental or conductive to the full accomplishment of the foregoing objects.

(f) To acquire, own, use, convey and otherwise dispose of and deal with or in real property or any interest therein and to carry on a general lodging business for transient and permanent trade and any or all allied and kindred businesses thereto including therein the right to operate in connection therewith a tavern, cafe

or restaurant and to also have the right to operate such other services as may be found necessary in connection with the operation of a general lodge or hotel business.

III.

This corporation shall have the power, authority and capacity as follows:

(a) It shall have capacity to act possessed by natural persons, but it shall have authority to perform only such acts as are necessary or proper to accomplish its purposes and which are not repugnant to law;

(b) Without limiting or enlarging the grant of authority contained in subdivision 1, Section 30-114, Idaho Code, it is hereby provided that such corporation shall have authority;

(1) To have succession by its corporate name for the time stated in its articles of incorporation, and when no period is limited, perpetually;

(2) To sue and be sued, appear, complain and defend in any court of law or equity, or before any board, commission or tribunal;

(3) To have and use a corporate seal which may be altered at pleasure;

(4) To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, convey, mortgage and/or lease, real and personal property; to dispose of, sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage and/or convey any rights, privileges, franchises, real or personal property of the corporation other than its franchise of being a corporation, and to acquire, purchase, guaranty, hold, mortgage, own, vote, sell, pledge and/or otherwise dispose of and deal in shares, bonds,

securities and debentures and other evidences of indebtedness of other corporations, domestic or foreign.

(5) To appoint such officers, employees and agents as the business of the corporation may require and to allow them compensation;

(6) To make by-laws not inconsistent with any existing law for the management of its business and property, the regulation and conduct of its affairs, and the certification and transfer of its stock, and optionally to provide penalties for the breach thereof not exceeding twenty dollars for any one offense.

(7) To issue shares and admit shareholders, and to sell their shares for the payment of assessments or installments;

(8) To enter into contracts or obligations of any type or kind essential, necessary or proper to the transaction of its ordinary affairs, or for the purposes of the corporation.

(9) To conduct business in this state and to acquire, receive, hold purchase, lease, mortgage, dispose of and/or convey real and personal property situate out of this state, provided such powers are included within the objects set forth in its articles of incorporation.

(10) To do all acts as are necessary and expedient to accomplish its stated purposes.

IV.

The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

V.

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation is Pocatello, Bannock County, Idaho.

VI.

The capital stock of the corporation shall be \$25,000.00, divided into 25,000 shares of common stock of the par value of \$1.00 each.
