

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I:

The name of the non-profit 90 5 the 1 59 Templepoint Publishing, Inc.

ARTICLE II:

The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE III:

The period of duration of the corporation is PERPETUAL.

ARTICLE IV:

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is for the publishing, distribution and sales of religious and educational material; and, any other transaction of any or all lawful business for which non-profit corporations may be incorporated in the State of Idaho.
