First. That the name of the corporation is and shall be the "Victor Mining Company."

Second. That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are to acquire, hold, plat into City and Town lots, sell, lease and mortgage lands and real estate in the States of Washington and Idaho; to locate, acquire, procure, hold, buy, sell, lease and operate mines and mining claims of all kinds in the States of Washington and Idaho; to carry on selling the business of purchasing, milling, smelting, matting, stamping and reducing ores and minerals of every kind and description in the States of Washington and Idaho. And to acquire, lease and operate water rights and flumes for the purpose of mining and reducing ores and running and operating electrical machinery, and for any and all purposes in the States of Washington and Idaho. To purchase, acquire, hold, erect, and operate electric light and power plants for the purpose of mining and treating ores, and for the purpose of furnishing lights and creating power for all purposes in the States of Washington and Idaho.

Third. That the principal place of business, where the business of this corporation is transacted shall be in the City of Spokane, County of Spokane, State of Washington.

Fourth. That the term for which this corporation is to exist is fifty years, from and after the date of its incorporation.
