CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ~~JAS. H. FOUNE~~, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

MERIDIAN BOWLING LANES, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **eleventh** day of **March,** A.D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-Nine,** and duly recorded on Film No. **106** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at

Meridian, in the County of **Ada.**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
MERIDIAN BOWLING LANES, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of legal age, and citizens of the United States, do hereby associate ourselves together with the purpose of forming a corporation under the provisions of the laws of the State of Idaho, and do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation, to-wit:

I.

The name of the corporation shall be MERIDIAN BOWLING LANES, INC.

II.

The nature, objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed shall be:

(a) To engage generally in the bowling alley business and related businesses; to plan, design and construct buildings for bowling and recreational purposes and to buy, sell and acquire the same and all equipment connected therewith; to operate, conduct and carry on the bowling alley business and the accommodations necessary or desirable to accomplish such purposes; to conduct and carry on the business of providing meals and food for the general public, and buying and selling any and all other things necessary or desirable in connection with the operation of a bowling business; to undertake and carry on any business transaction or operation commonly undertaken or carried on by bowling alley and the other recreation businesses, and generally to institute, enter into, assist, promote and participate in any such business or operation, and to act as the agent for all

persons, corporations, partnerships or associations for this purpose.

(b) To introduce, erect, operate, conduct, manage, maintain, and carry on a restaurant, cafe and cabaret business; to buy, sell, lease or otherwise dispose of, and to operate, conduct, furnish, equip and manage restaurants, inns, eating houses, taverns, cabarets, cafes or places of entertainment and generally to do and perform everything necessary for carrying out the aforesaid purposes. To buy or otherwise acquire, manufacture, market, prepare for market, sell, deal in and deal with, import and export food and food products of every class and description, fresh, canned, preserved or otherwise, and to prepare and serve all food, beverages, alcoholic or non-alcoholic, and other preparations and refreshments of all kinds.

(c) To carry on and conduct in all its branches and departments as principal or agent, the business of bowling alleys or wholesale merchants of bowling alleys and equipment, furniture, fixtures, household appliances and household furnishings of every type and character, and to repair, service and maintain bowling alleys, bowling balls, and pins both manual and automatic, and other bowling equipment, and all business incidental or in anyway connected therewith.

(d) To purchase, own, operate and conduct storage and parking facilities for automobiles and motor vehicles and to purchase, own and sell land, buildings, material, equipment, machinery, appliances and personal property used or to be used in the operation of storage and parking facilities for automobiles and motor vehicles.

(e) To buy, sell and deal in all kinds of contracts, notes, bills of sale, mortgages and other evidences of debt, and the security for the payment of the same; to buy and sell all forms of insurance and to act as agent for insurance com-

panies; to discount or negotiate notes, bills and other evidence of debt; to buy, sell, own and hold shares of capital stock of other corporations.

(f) To acquire by purchase, subscription or otherwise, and to hold and hypothecate, and to dispose of stocks, bonds, or any other obligation of all kinds; and to sell, trade in and exchange the same, and all classes of stocks, bonds, notes, bills of sale and other securities.

(g) To buy, hold, purchase, contract for, own, sell, mortgage, lease, or exchange real or personal property of all kinds.

(h) To carry into effect the object and purpose aforesaid, this corporation is authorized to do all and singular the things necessary and convenient to carry out the general purposes for which it is organized.

(i) All the foregoing provisions of this Article II are to be construed both as objects and powers, and it is hereby expressly provided that the enumeration herein of specific powers and objects shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general purposes and powers of the corporation; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize or permit the corporation to carry on any business or to exercise any power or do any act which a corporation formed under the laws of the State of Idaho now or hereafter existing may not, at the time, lawfully carry on or do. It is the intention that the purpose, objects and powers specified in each of the paragraphs of this Article II shall, except as otherwise provided, in no wise be limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause or paragraph in these Articles contained or of any other provisions of this Articles of Incorporation.

III.

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

IV.

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation is and shall be Meridian, Idaho.

V.

The total authorized number of shares which may be issued by this corporation is One Thousand Shares of common stock with a par value of One Hundred and No/100 (\$100.00) Dollars per share and non-assessable.

VI.

All shares of this corporation are the same class with equal rights and voting power and without preference or priority of any share over any other share.

VII.


