ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ROCKY MOUNTAIN HARVESTORE, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being of full age and at least two-thirds of whom are citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho.

And we hereby certify in writing:

I.

That the name of the corporation shall be Rocky Mountain Harvestore, Inc.

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(1) To carry on the business as wholesalers, retailers, and manufacturers of goods, wares, merchandise and personal property of every class and description, including, but not limited to, silos, granaries, and other feed storage buildings and equipment, agricultural equipment and machines, mechanical and electrical machines and appliances, parts and accessories for all of the foregoing, and hardware; to hold, own, acquire, or sell franchises for the manufacture or sale of goods, wares, merchandise and equipment; and to hold, own, sell or otherwise dispose of, trade, deal in and deal with the same and to purchase, own, lease and deal in real property of all kinds.

(2) To engage and operate in the business of repairing, servicing, building and erecting any and all kinds of personal property, including, but not limited to, silos and storage facilities for livestock feed, mechanical and electrical machines and appliances.

(3) To acquire, hold, own and operate farms and agricultural lands; to engage in general farming business as landlord or tenant or either or both of such capacities; and generally to engage in any and all types of agricultural occupation and pursuit.

(4) To engage in any and all types of commercial and industrial enterprise and in connection therewith to exercise all the powers granted to corporations by law.

1 (5) To lend money and negotiate loans; to draw, accept, endorse,
2 discount, sell and deliver bills of exchange, promissory notes, bonds, obligations,
3 securities of any government, authority or company; to form, promote, subsidize
4 and assist companies, firms, and partnerships of all kinds; to act as surety and
5 guarantor in any and all types of engagements, including the power to execute,
6 endorse and deliver contracts and to guarantee the prompt and faithful perform-
7 ance and payments of debts, notes, agreements, contracts and undertakings of any
8 other person, firm, partnership or corporation; and including also the power to
9 act as an accommodation co-maker or guarantor of obligations either as a primary
10 or secondary obligor; to enter into any arrangement with any authorities, municipi-
11 pal, local or otherwise conducive to the company's objects or any of them, and to
12 obtain from any such government or authority any rights, privileges and con-
13 cessions which the company may deem desirable to obtain, and to carry out,
14 exercise and comply with any such arrangement, rights, privileges and concessions.
15 Generally to carry on and undertake any business, undertaking, transaction or
16 operation commonly carried on or undertaken by merchants or manufactures or
17 which may seem to the company capable of being conveniently carried on or
18 calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any
19 of the company's property or rights.

20 (6) To acquire the good will, rights, property and assets of all
21 kinds and undertake the whole or any part of the liabilities of any person, firm,
22 association, or corporation on such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon
23 and to pay for the same in cash, stocks, bonds, debentures and other securities
24 of this corporation or otherwise; and to acquire and take all or any part of the
25 business assets and liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation.

26 (7) To enter into contracts and agreements of partnership or joint
27 ventures with individuals or other persons, firms or corporations for the purpose
28 of engaging in any and all kinds of lawful business ventures or enterprises, and
29 in this connection to do and perform all of the acts authorized to corporations
30 pursuant to the purposes herein set forth in this and the preceding paragraphs
31 enumerating the purposes of this corporation.

32 (8) The enumeration of any specific purposes of this corporation

herein above set forth shall be deemed to be in furtherance and not in limitation of the general purposes of the said corporation as hereinabove set forth.

III.

That the term for which said corporation shall exist is perpetual.

IV.

That the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho shall be located at Twin Falls, in the County of Twin Falls, State of Idaho; and that the post office address of the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho is Twin Falls, Idaho.

V.

That the amount of the capital stock of said corporation shall be \$50,000.00 divided into 500 shares of a par value of \$100.00 each, and the total authorized number of shares shall be 500 and their aggregate par value \$50,000.00.


