forming a Corporation under, and pursuant to the laws
of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE I

WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

That the name of this corporation shall be
NEWBORN OF LIFE, INC.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES:

Section A. The specific and primary purposes are missionary, religious, charitable, and benevolent; especially to communicate in writing, teaching, preaching, and/or all methods which are spiritually and lawfully right The Gospel of Jesus Christ and The Kingdom of Heaven.

Section B. General purposes are to promote and support the conducting of religious services, Bible schools, monasteries, to minister to the sick and needy, care for the fatherless, and to rescue the fallen, to work at promotion of Christian faith, virtue, and charity. To procure, administrate, and conduct schools (for the study of the Holy Bible), monasteries, temples, missions and homes. To educate, ordain, support, and appoint priests, ministers, evangelists, missionaries, and workers to carry out the specific and primary purposes nationally and universally.

ARTICLE III

OPERATION AND BY LAWS:

Section A. To own, improve, manage, control and operate real and personal property as is permitted under the Laws governing such corporation.

Section B. To set up, adopt, change and ammend By Laws for the governing of this corporation and the actions of its directors, officers, ministers, or other members which will enhance our purposes or further our services.

ARTICLE IV

FINANCE:

To solicit, accept, or receive such divers gifts of real estate; and to accept and receive or solicit gifts, donations and bequests of personal property; to use or convey the same into money or negotiable values for the use and benefits of the corporation and its purposes. To borrow, mortgage, secure loans from real estate; to erect buildings on its real estate for economy, convenience, necessity of purposes; to buy, sell, mortgage, hypothecate, pledge, lease, hold, control, and contract buildings, apartments, and lands of every kind national and universal, and appliances, furnishings, and equipment necessary and convenient for the work of said corporation. To hold all property both real and personal including shares, stocks, money conveyances, paper, securities of other corporations; to act as trustees under any or all principles of the laws subject to corporations; receive, hold administrate, and to expend funds and properties subject to these trust and to do any other lawful act subject to the administration of affairs, methods, and purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE V

TRANSPORTATION:

To convey and hold ways and means of conveyances and transportation in the business of this corporation; to own, receive, and secure transportation methods for the officers, ministers, members, appointees, attachees, in the convenient operation of their offices.

ARTICLE VI

NONPROFIT CLAUSE

This shall be a noncompetitive corporation. It shall be a corporation of nonprofit to its members and officers.

ARTICLE VII

INCORPORATION CODE

This corporation is organized pursuant to the General Nonprofit Corporation Law of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE VIII

MEMBERSHIP

All privileges (including property and voting rights), qualifications, limitations, financial responsibilities, and classes of individual membership are equal. The administration of the for going shall be set forth in the By Laws.

ARTICLE IX

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE

The office in this State shall be the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is located in Ada County.


ARTICLE X

TERMS

The term of this corporation shall be perpetual. The corporation shall have a Executive Board of Directors with at least five members. The Executive Board shall consist of President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and six members of president, vice president, business administrator, secretary, and treasurer. The administrative board shall function as a six member advisory staff and shall by majority vote make replacements to the Executive Board of Directors. The six members of the administrative board shall be appointed by the Executive Board of Directors at all annual meetings. 
