### CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

I, Ira H. Masters, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the

**CHURCH OF THE ASCENSION, TWIN FALLS, IDAHO, INC.**

a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, filed in this office on the **14th** day of **February, 1956**,

original articles of amendment, as provided by Sections 30-1103, 30-1105, Idaho Code, amending Article III, vestrymen to be qualified men and women electors of the parish; Article V, Section 1, Annual Meeting during month of January; and Article X, attendance at vestry meetings

and that the said articles of amendment contain the statement of facts required by law, and are recorded on Film No. **93** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho,

I THEREFORE FURTHER CERTIFY, That the Articles of Incorporation have been amended accordingly.

AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE  
CHURCH OF THE ASCENSION, TWIN FALLS, IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That the Articles of Incorporation of the Church of the Ascension, Twin Falls, Idaho, Inc., a religious corporation organized on the 8th day of December, 1944 pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Idaho Code, are hereby amended as follows:

Section 4. of Article III of said Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

"ARTICLE III

Section 4. The Vestrymen shall be qualified men and women electors of the parish."

Section 1. of Article V of said Articles of Incorporation is hereby amended to read as follows, to-wit:

"ARTICLE V

Section 1. The qualified electors of the Parish shall meet annually during the month of January. The meeting in 1944 shall be on December 4th, and said electors shall then elect two Wardens and three Vestrymen who shall continue in office for one year, or until their successors are elected and qualified; three Vestrymen to serve for two years, or until their successors are elected and qualified; and three Vestrymen to serve for three years, or until their successors are elected and qualified. Thereafter, at each annual Parish meeting, whenever the terms of office of any Vestrymen shall expire as herein provided, their successors shall be elected for a full term of three years each, or until their successors are elected and qualified. Provided however, that no Vestryman shall serve for two consecutive three year terms."

Said Articles of Incorporation are further amended by adding thereto a new Article designated Article X, which shall read as follows, to-wit:

"ARTICLE X ATTENDANCE AT VESTRY MEETINGS.

Section 1. Should any vestryman or either of the Jr. or Sr. Wardens, after having been elected and after having taken his office, miss three consecutive meetings, without first having submitted an excuse to the Rector to be approved by the Vestry, shall automatically resign his position and be replaced the same as if a vacancy

had occurred on the Vestry as provided in  
ARTICLE V Section 2.

Except as amended above, all of the original provisions  
set forth in said Articles of Incorporation are hereby in all res-  
pects ratified and confirmed.

Twin Falls County wherein such meeting was held, to-wit, in the  
Times-News on Dec. 29, 1955 January 5, January 12,  
and January 19, 1956 and that such notice designated  
the regular meeting at which it was intended to vote and at which  
it was voted on the proposition of amending said Articles of In-  
corporation and said notice stated the manner in which it was in-  
tended to amend said Articles of Incorporation, which proposed  
amendments set forth in substance the amendments duly adopted at  
said meeting as hereinabove set forth at length.

That affiant, as secretary of the corporation, was the secretary at said meeting and makes this affidavit concerning the amendment of said Articles pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 11 of the Idaho Code.
