I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

ASSEMBLY OF GOD CHURCH OF SANDPOINT, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twenty-fifth** day of **January** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-one** and is duly recorded on Film No. **113** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Sandpoint** in the County of **Bonner** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ASSEMBLY OF GOD CHURCH OF SANDPOINT

KNOW ALL MEN that we, the undersigned, all of whom are residents of
of full age,
the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves
together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State
of Idaho, and in pursuance of the purposes for which we have been elected,
as hereinafter set forth, a religious corporation to be known as Assembly
of God Church of Sandpoint.

Article I.

The name of this corporation shall be ASSEMBLY OF GOD CHURCH OF
SANDPOINT, INC.

Article II.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be in the
City of Sandpoint, County of Bonner, State of Idaho.

Article III.

The term of the incorporation shall be perpetual.

Article IV.

The objects for which this corporation is formed are:

To preach and teach the word of God; to do missionary
work all over the world and general religious work
everywhere.

To purchase, own, hold, sell, convey, mortgage or
otherwise hypothecate real estate and personal property
of all kinds and descriptions necessary or incident to,
or in connection with its church work.

Article V.

That the number of directors who shall have the management of its
affairs as aforesaid shall be, and the names of the directors or trustees
elected for the current year are:

Melford Niebuhr,	Sandpoint, Idaho
Ivar Hedlund,	Samuels, Idaho
John Olsen,	Sandpoint, Idaho

That the said trustees were duly elected at a meeting of the members of
said church, and were authorized by a majority vote of the members on

December 27, 1960, to incorporate this body of members. That notice of the meeting so held was in words and figures as follows:

That said notice was duly published for two (2) successive weeks prior to the meeting in The Sandpoint News-Bulletin, a newspaper printed and published in Sandpoint, Idaho, and said notice was also posted conspicuously for two (2) weeks at the place where the meeting was held.

The affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Trustees consisting of three in number. Other officers may be elected such as may be deemed necessary by the members. The said Board of Trustees and other officers shall be elected one each year for a term of three years by the members of this corporation, from its membership, at their regular annual meeting.

Article VII.

The terms of admission to this body are and shall be:

One must accept the Bible as it is written and all evidence of salvation through repentance and faith to become a member of this body.
