Attached Articles of Incorporation for Soldier Mountain Recreation Association

Purpose: The purpose of the SMRA is to expand upon an outdoor lifestyle, known and enjoyed by the communities of South Central Idaho. To preserve the family values, legacies and heritage of Soldier Mountain Ski Area, while exploring opportunities to provide education, expand recreation options and upgrade quality of service, for the benefit of the general public. SMRA is a Non Profit 501(c)(3) corporation.

Dissolution: Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
