## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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INDIAN VALLEY - GRAY'S UREEK DITCH.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

Manning, and A. L. Hutchison, all being bone fide residents of the State of Idaho, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, to be known by the corporate name of Indian Valley-Gray's Greak Ditch", and we do hereby certify:--

### ARTICLE I.

That the name of said corporation shall be "Indian Valley-Gray's Creek Ditch".

## ARTICLE II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are as follows, to-wit:--

To acquire, own, hold and operate an irrigation canal leading from a point on the Little Weiser River in Adams County, Idaho, to and upon the lands of the stock holders of said corporation, and to carry through said canal to and upon the lands of its stock holders, water for irrigation and domestic purposes diverted through said canal from said Little Weiser River under appropriations thereof made by its said stock holders.

and to distribute the same to its said stock holders ratably and proportionately to the shares of stock which its stock holders hold of the capital stock of said corporation, and to do any and all things necessary and proper to be done in conducting the business of said corporation, and to carry out the purposes hereinbefore mantioned.

#### ARTICLES III.

That the principal place of business of said corporation shall be at Indian Valley, County of Adams, State of Idaho.

#### ARTICLES IV.

The term of existence of said corporation shall be fifty years.

### ARTICLE V.

The Board of Directors of said corporation shall consist of five members.

# ARTICLE VI.

That the capital stock of said corporation shall be Sixteen Hundred Five (\$1605.00) Dollars, divided into Sixteen Hundred Five shares of the par value of One Dollar each.

# ARTICLE VII.

That the emount of said capital stock which has actually been subscribed in Sixteen Hundred Five (\$1605.00) Dollars, and the following are the names of the persons by

### ARTICLE VIII.

That the Board of Directors of said corporation for the first year shall consist of L. A. Thompson, J. I. Linder, E. Manning, A. L. Hutchison and Thos. Hutchison.

### ARTICLE IX.

That each of the several stock holders of said corporation shall have the right to carry through said canal to and upon their respective lands one miners inch, measured under a four inch pressure, of water for each and every share of stock owned by said stock holders respectively.

## ARTICLS X.

That said corporation shall have power to borrow money and to execute and negotiate notes, bonds, or other obligations for the payment of money for the purpose of raising revenue to

defray the expenses of the maintenance and operation of said conal; and shall have power to fix, charge and collect from its stock holders, reasonable tolls, rentals, maintenance or service charges in such manner as may be determined by regulations or by-laws adopted for that purpose, or by means of assessments levied upon its stock in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho, for raising money for the purpose of raising revenue to defrey the costs of maintenance and operation of said canal, and for no other purpose.
