

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

I, the undersigned individual of legal age and a resident of the State of Idaho and a citizen of the United States, and the sole member and Director of DRUG BUSTERS, Inc., pursuant to Idaho Code §30-3-94, state the Articles of Incorporation of DRUG BUSTERS, Inc., as follows:

ARTICLE ONE  
NAME

The name of the corporation is DRUG BUSTERS, INC.

ARTICLE TWO  
PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of the corporation is 315 Deinhard Lane, McCall, Idaho 83638.

ARTICLE THREE  
DURATION

The corporation shall have perpetual duration.

ARTICLE FOUR  
PURPOSES

To engage in any lawful methods of preventing and discouraging the use drugs of and other illegal activities. Recognizing that drugs pose a clear and present danger to our lives and way of life. It is the corporation's purpose to discourage illegal drugs and activities by such things as monitoring the court system to insure penalties, provided by law, are uniformly and fully imposed; will encourage diligent law enforcement and will otherwise discourage drug usage and related illegal activities.

ARTICLE FIVE  
MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall have the authority to issue membership certificates in the corporation under such provisions as may be adopted by the Board of Directors.

**ARTICLE ELEVEN  
LIMITATION OF LIABILITY**

The members of this corporation shall not as such be personally liable for acts, debts, liabilities or obligations of the Corporation.

**ARTICLE TWELVE  
VOTING POWER**

The voting power of the members of this corporation shall be equal with one (1) vote per member.

**ARTICLE THIRTEEN  
AMENDMENTS**

These stated articles may be amended or restated in the manner provided by law at the time of amendment.

**ARTICLE FOURTEEN  
DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION**

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine.
