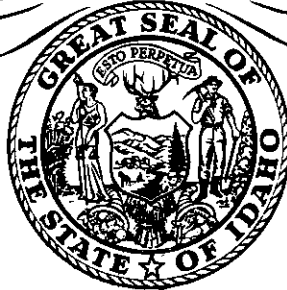

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

HOPE LUTHERAN CHURCH OF IDAHO FALLS, INC.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Twenty-fourth** day of **January,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-two** and is duly recorded on Film No. **114** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Idaho Falls** in the County of **Bonneville** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
HOPE LUTHERAN CHURCH OF IDAHO FALLS, INC.

We, the undersigned, do hereby certify that we are the duly elected Board of Trustees of Hope Lutheran Church of Idaho Falls, a religious organization and duly authorized and directed to form this corporation under and pursuant to the Laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby associate ourselves for the purpose of forming a religious corporation, and for this purpose we hereby certify:

I.

The name of this corporation shall be Hope Lutheran Church of Idaho Falls, Inc.

II.

The purposes and objects for which said corporation is formed are:

To establish, maintain and provide a place of public worship; to establish, maintain and conduct schools for religious education and to further other religious and charitable work; to preach the word of God and administer the sacraments in accordance with the confessional standards and practices of the Lutheran Church, Missouri Synod; to establish, maintain and provide a school for the education of the young in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho.

III.

That the place where the principal business is to be transacted shall be Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho.

IV.

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

V.

The Board of Directors of this corporation shall be the Board of Trustees of the local Church, duly elected and organized as prescribed in the By-laws of this corporation

VI.

The corporation shall have the power to acquire and hold title in fee simple, in trust or otherwise, to both real and personal property, and to improve, encumber, sell, convey and dispose of all such property to promote the business and objects of said corporation

VII.

The Board of Trustees of this Corporation shall consist of not fewer than three (3) nor more than twenty (20) persons, each of whom shall not be less than 21 years of age.

VIII.

This corporation is formed for religious purposes and not for profit.

IX.

The members of this corporation shall not be liable for the debts of this corporation.

That public notice of the election of the Board of Trustees and the intent to incorporate said congregation was given by publication at least once a week for two weeks in the Post-Register, a newspaper published in Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, the city in which said meeting was held, and also posted for a like period at the place where the meeting was held. At the meeting a quorum was present and voted, and the undersigned were unanimously elected the Board of Trustees for the congregation, and were duly authorized and directed to proceed with the incorporation of said congregation.



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

We, the undersigned, do hereby certify that we acted as presiding officer and secretary, respectively, at a special meeting of the members of Hope Lutheran Church of Idaho Falls; that said meeting was held at the Hope Lutheran Church, 1370 East 17th Street, Idaho Falls, Idaho, on the 10th day of January, 1962, at 7:30 p.m.; and by unanimous vote of members attending said meeting, a quorum of which was present, Gerald Thomas, Sam Sato and Carl Johnson were duly elected the Board of Trustees of said Church.

At said meeting the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Hope Lutheran Church of Idaho Falls incorporate said Church to be known in its corporate name as Hope Lutheran Church of Idaho Falls, Inc.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Board of Trustees be, and they are hereby, authorized and directed to do any and all things which are by law required to complete and carry into effect the above Resolution.

That notice of the time and place for the holding of such meeting was given by publication for at least once a week for two weeks in the Post-Register, a newspaper published in Idaho Falls, Idaho, where said meeting was held; that a written notice was posted in a conspicuous place where such election was held for a period of two weeks prior to the time said election was held.
