



Jarman & Tranmer, P.A.

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The undersigned natural persons, each more than 18 years of age, hereby establish a professional service corporation pursuant to the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 13 of the Idaho Code, and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

- Name. The name of the Corporation is JARMAN
 TRANMER, P.A.
- 2. **Duration.** The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.
- 3. Purpose and powers. (a) The Corporation is organized solely for the purpose of conducting the practice of law only through persons qualified to practice law in the State of Idaho. Such persons shall practice the profession of law in accordance with all rules for professional conduct promulgated by the Supreme Court of the State of Idaho. The Corporation shall at all times comply with standards of professional conduct promulgated by such court.

1. ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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(b) The Corporation may exercise the powers and privileges now or hereafter conferred upon corporations by Idaho law only in furtherance of and subject to the limitations stated in the preceding paragraph designated 3(a).

4. Qualification of shareholders. All shareholders of the Corporation shall be persons duly licensed by the Supreme Court of the State of Idaho to practice law in the State of Idaho. They shall also be individuals who, except for time spent for illness, accident, in the armed services, on vactions, and on leaves of absence not to exceed one year, are actively engaged in the practice of law in the offices of the Corporation. All shares of any shareholder who ceases to be eligible to be a shareholder of the Corporation shall be sold or transferred in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 7.

5. Authorized shares. The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is 500 common shares, each having a par value of \$100.00.

6. Voting. Each shareholder of record shall have one vote for each share of stock standing in his name on the books of the Corporation. Cumulative voting for the election of directors is not permitted.

7. Purchase or transfer upon eligibility. Within 30 days after any shareholder ceases to be eligible to be a shareholder, the Corporation shall purchase all of the shares he owns or such shares shall be transferred to a qualified person as described in Article 4. The price to be paid by the Corporation and the schedule of payments shall be as specified in the Bylaws, and if no price or schedule is so specified, the price shall be the pro rata net book value thereof as of the last day of the month preceding the date of purchase and payment shall be made in cash against receipt of the shares.

8. Liability. The shareholders of the Corporation shall be jointly and severally liable for all acts, errors and omissions of the employees of the Corporation.

3. ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

9. Initial directors. Two directors shall constitute the initial board, their names and addresses being as follows:

The President of the Corporation shall be a shareholder and director. All other officers and directors of the Corporation ot the extent possible shall be persons eligible to be shareholders.

10. Management of corporation. The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by the shareholders of the Corporation and the Board of Directors.

The Board shall be authorized to manage only so much of the business and affairs of the Corporation as shall from time to time be delegated to it by the shareholders by means of Bylaws or otherwise.

Only directors and officers of the Corporation who are eligible to be shareholders shall exercise any authority with respect to professional decisions and matters relating to the practice of law.

The right to amend or repeal the Bylaws and to adopt new Bylaws is reserved to shareholders.

- 11. Address. The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 123 North Main, Pocatello, Idaho. The name of its initial registered agent at such address is Ronald Jarman. The Corporation may conduct part or all of its business in any other part of Idaho.
- 12. Certified copy. A copy of these Articles and all amendments thereto in each case certified by the the Secretary of State shall be filed with the Clerk of the Supreme Court of the State of Idaho.
