ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE BRADLEY CORPORATION

FIRST. The name of this corporation is The Bradley Corporation.

SECOND. The period of duration of this corporation shall be perpetual, or until such time as indicated by a majority vote of the stockholders.

THIRD. The purposes for which this corporation is organized are to do any or all the things herein mentioned, as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, to engage in any lawful act or activity, and to transact any or all lawful business for which corporations may be organized under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH. The amount of the total authorized stock of this corporation is one hundred (100) shares of no par value.

FIFTH. Each stockholder shall offer to the Corporation or to other stockholders of the Corporation a thirty day "first refusal" option to purchase his or her stock should he or she elect to sell his or her stock.

SIXTH. The registered office of the Corporation in the State of Idaho is to be located at Bennington, Bear Lake County, Idaho, with the mailing address of

SEVENTH. The name and mailing address of the incorporator is as follows:

EIGHTH. The powers of the incorporator are to continue upon the filing of the Articles of Incorporation, and he shall serve as the director until the first meeting of stockholders or until his successor is elected and qualifies.

NINTH. The Director shall have power to make and to alter or amend the By-Laws; to fix the amount to be reserved as working capital, and to authorize and cause to be executed, mortgages and liens without limit as to the amount, upon the property and franchise of the Corporation.

With the consent in writing, and pursuant to a vote of the holders of a majority of the capital stock issued and outstanding, the Director shall have the authority to dispose, in any manner, of the whole property of this corporation.

The By-Laws shall determine whether and to what extent the accounts and books of this corporation, or any of them shall be open to the inspection of the stockholders; and no stockholder shall have any right of inspecting any account, or book or document of this Corporation, except as conferred by the law or the By-Laws, or by resolution of the stockholders.

The stockholders and director(s) shall have power to hold their meetings and keep the books, documents and papers of the Corporation outside of the State of Idaho, at such places as may be from time to time designated by the By-Laws or by resolution of the stockholders or director(s), except as otherwise required by the laws of Idaho.

It is the intention that the purposes and powers specified in the Third paragraph hereof shall, except where otherwise specified in said paragraph, be nowise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause or paragraph in this Article of Incorporation, but that the objects, purposes and powers specified in the Third paragraph and in each of the clauses or paragraphs of this charter shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes and powers.

I, THE UNDERSIGNED, for the purpose of forming a Corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, do make, file and record this Article and do certify that the facts herein are true; and I have accordingly hereunto set my hand.
