ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION.

Know all men by these presents, That the undersigned,

while residents of the state of Wisconsin, do hereby make, sign and
agree to the following:

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION.

Article First. -- The undersigned have associated and do hereby associate themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under chapter 86, of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1898, the business and purposes of which corporation shall be to purchase, hold, improve and sell real estate; to cut, haul, drive and sell logs, poles and timber; and to manufacture and sell lumber, lath, shingles and fuel, which said business may be carried on in the United States and in foreign countries.

Article Second. -- The name of said corporation shall be some shall be some shall be in the city of New Richmond, county of St. Croix and state of Wisconsin, where its principal books of account and corporation records shall be kept.

Article Third. -- The capital stock of said corporation shall be Two Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Dollars (\$225,000.00) and the same shall consist of 2,250 shares, each of which said shares shall be of a face or par value of \$100.00.

Article Fourth .-- The general officers of said corporation shall be a President, Vice-President, General Manager, Secretary and Treasurer; and the board of directors shall consist of five stock holders.

Article Fifth. -- The principal duties of the President shall be to preside at all meetings of the board of directors and of the members of the corporation, and to have general supervision of the affairs of the corporation.

The principal duties of the Vice-President shall be to dischar; the duties of the President in the event of the absence or disability, for any cause whatever, of the latter.

The principal duties of the General Manager shall be to attend to and carry on the details of the business under the supervision and direction of the President.

The principal duties of the Secretary shall be to countersign all deeds, leases and conveyances executed by the corporation, affix the seal of the dorporation thereto, and to such other papers as shall be required or directed to be sealed, and to keep a record of the proceedings of the Board of Directors, and to safely and systematically keep all books, papers, records and documents belonging to the corporation, or in any wise pertaining to the business thereof.

The principal dut ies of the Treasurer shall be to keep and account for all moneys, credits and property, of any and every nature, of the corporation, which shall come into his hands, and keep an accurate account of all moneys received and disbursed, and to render such accounts, statements and inventories of moneys received and disbursed, and of money and property on hand, as shall be required by the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors may provide for the appointment of such additional officers as they may deem for the best interests of the corporation.

Whenever the Board of Directors may so order, the offices of Secretary and Treasurer may be held by the same person.

The said officers shall perform such additional or different duties as shall from time to time be imposed or required by the Board of Directors, or as may be prescribed from time to t ime by the by-laws.

Article Sixth .-- Only persons holding stock according to the regulations of the corporation shall be members of it.

Article Seventh. -- These articles may be amended by resolution, setting forth such amendment of amendments, adopted at any meeting of the stockholders by a vote of at least two-thirds of all the stock of said corporation then outstanding.

Article Eighth. -- There shall be a meeting of the stockholders of said corporation held each year, on the second Wednesday in January, at the office of said corporation in New Richmond, Wisconsin, and at which meeting a board of directors shall be chosen for the ensuing years and there shall be a meeting of the board of directors so chosen in the

All directors and officers shall hold their offices until the second Wednesday in January succeeding their election or appointment, and until their successors are duly elected or appointed.
