The undersigned, who is duly licensed to practice engineering in the State of Idaho, desire to form a professional corporation pursuant to I.C. 30-1301 et seq. For the purpose of rendering engineering services, and adopts the following articles of incorporation for such incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

Name.

The name of this Corporation is MORELL ENGINEERING, P.C.

ARTICLE II.

Period of Duration.

The duration of this Corporation is to be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

Purposes and Powers.

Section 1. Purposes. The purpose for which this Corporation is organized is to engage in the general practice of engineering. Such professional services shall only be rendered through the corporation's officers, employees (as defined in I.C. 30-1305), and agents who are duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render such professional services in Idaho.

Section 2. Powers. In connection with the above-mentioned purpose, the corporation shall have the power to invest its funds in real estate, mortgages, stock, bonds, or any other type of investment and to acquire, own, and dispose of real and personal property, and to transact and engage in any and all lawful acts for which professional service corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Idaho and shall have all the powers specified in the Idaho Professional Service corporation Act.

ARTICLE IV.

Stock Clauses.

The aggregate number of shares which this Corporation shall have authority to issue is 100 common shares, no par value. The Corporation shall not have the authority to issue shares in series.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION - 1

Stock shall be issued only to persons who are licensed to practice engineering in the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

Registered Office and Registered Agent.

ARTICLE VI.

Directors.

The number of Directors shall be as specified in the Bylaws of this Corporation and such number may from time to time be increased or decreased in such manner as described in the Bylaws and may be fewer than three in the event that the Corporation has less than three shareholders, in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho. Provisions for Regulation of Corporation's Internal Affairs.

Section 1. <u>Meetings of Shareholders and Directors</u>. Meetings of the Shareholders and Directors of this Corporation may be held either within or without the State of Idaho at such place or places as may from time to time be designated in the Bylaws or by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. <u>Bylaws</u>. The initial Bylaws of this Corporation shall be adopted by its Board of Directors. The power to amend or repeal the Bylaws or to adopt new Bylaws shall be in the Directors, as set forth in the Bylaws. The Bylaws may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of this corporation which are consistent with the Idaho Professional Service Corporation Act and these

Articles of Incorporation.

Section 3. <u>Compensation of Directors</u>. The Board of Directors shall not receive compensation for their services as directors. A director may serve the corporation in any other capacity and may receive compensation therefrom in any form.

Section 4. <u>Contracts in which Directors Have an Interest</u>. The Bylaws of the corporation shall provide for the handling of contracts or transactions in which Directors may have a financial interest, whether direct or indirect.

Section 5. <u>Indemnification of Directors and Officers</u>. The Bylaws of the corporation shall provide for the circumstances in which Directors and officers of the corporation may be entitled to indemnification.

ARTICLE IX.

Amendment of Articles of Incorporation.

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in any respect conformable to the laws of the State of Idaho by an affirmative vote of more than seventy-five percent (75%) of the shareholders entitled to vote in a meeting of shareholders called for such purpose as prescribed by law.
