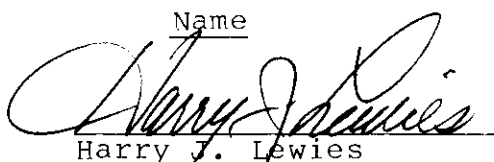

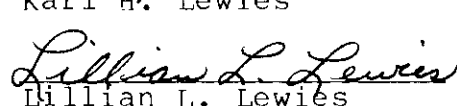
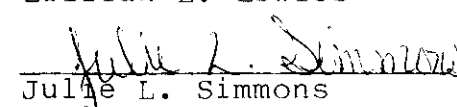

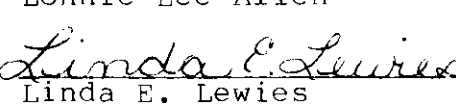
Shareholders' resolution adopted at meeting of 28th day of March, 1983:
