

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Now, the undersigned, Jay Gould, James F. Charlton and Charles J. Kuehne, all residents of the County of King, State of Washington, each of whom is a citizen of the United States, do hereby associate themselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the general incorporation laws of the State of Washington and do make and subscribe and adopt in triplicate the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be "INSURANCE PREMIUM STAMPS, INC."

ARTICLE II

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- (1) To engage in the trade stamp business.
- (2) To transact all lawful business of every kind and character in which it, by law this corporation may, be authorized at any time to engage in the State of Washington and in all other jurisdictions, including but not limited to the further specific objects and purposes mentioned in this Article.
- (3) To enter into and make, perform, and carry out contracts of every kind and description made for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, or corporation, either public or private, or with any municipality, county, state, territory, colony, province, nation, government, or agency or subdivision thereof;

(a) To purchase or otherwise acquire the whole or any part of the assets, business, goodwill, or right of any persons, firm, association, corporation, or organization, and to assume and undertake the whole or any part of the obligations thereof, to conduct the business of any such person, firm, association, or corporation, and to sell or otherwise dispose of the whole or any part of such property, business, goodwill, or rights;

(b) To acquire by purchase, subscription, or otherwise, and to own, hold, and maintain, assign, deal in and exchange, transfer, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate and otherwise deal in and dispose of any shares of the capital stock, script, or any voting trust certificate in respect of shares of capital stock of, or any bonds, notes, debentures, mortgages, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness issued or created by any other corporation, joint stock company, or any other state or government; and while the owner or holder of said shares of capital stock, script, voting trust certificate, bonds, notes, debentures, mortgages, and other securities, or evidences of indebtedness, to possess and exercise in respect thereof any and all rights, powers, and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote thereon;

(c) To borrow money for the business of the company and to give security therefor, and in pursuance of the business of the company to draw, make, accept, endorse, transfer, assign, execute, and issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes or other evidences of indebtedness, and for the purpose of securing any of its obligations or evidences of indebtedness or contracts, to convey, transfer, assign, mortgage, and/or pledge all or any part of the property or assets of the company, whether real or personal; to act as an accommodation maker or accommodation endorser or to guarantee the performance of the obligation of any person, firm, association, or corporation.

### ARTICLE III

The duration of this corporation shall be in perpetuity.

### ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation shall be at 706 Securities Building, Seattle 1, Washington.

### ARTICLE V

The authorized capital stock of this corporation shall consist of FIFTY thousand (50,000) shares of stock having no par or stated value.

### ARTICLE VI

That amount of paid in capital with which this corporation will begin business is the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00).

### ARTICLE VII

The number of Directors of this corporation shall at the commencement of business be three (3), but the Board of Directors may at any time, by amendment of the By-Laws, be increased to any number not exceeding nine (9) or decreased to any number not less than three (3). The names and post office addresses of the first Directors of the corporation, who shall serve until December 31, 1957, and until their successors are elected, are as follows:


