KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all full age citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be ST. JOE CEDAR, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- (a) To engage in a general logging, lumber, pole, timber, kiln drying, milling, construction materials, and merchandise business; to mammfacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, sell, or otherwise dispose of logs, lumber, weed products in a processed or unprocessed state, and by-products of wood or of said manufacturing operations, and building and construction supplies and merchandise, eitherat wholesale or retail.
- (b) To exercise generally the powers customarily exercised by business corporations and particularly the powers provided by the laws of the Stateof Idaho, referring especially to section 30-114 Idaho Code, in any State of the United States and throughout the world.
