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Article 8. Distribution Upon Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall distribute all the assets of the Corporation consistent with the purposes of the Corporation to such organization or organizations as shall at the time qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and which are not private foundations as defined under Section 509 of the Code in such manner as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so distributed shall be distributed by the district court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations as such court shall determine to be consistent with the purposes of the Corporation.
