#### ARTICIE 1.

That the name of said corporation is the Snake River Valley Sugar Company, Limited.

### ARTICER II.

That the purposes for which it is formed are to produce, manufacture, refine, buy, sell, and deal in sugars and syrups; to contract, buy, sell, lease, mortgage, and operate sugar factories, and to carry on all industries incident to the operation of sugar factories; to buy, sell, own, contract, lease, and mortgage real estate; to deal in live stock; own shares of stock in other corporations; buy, sell, lease, and otherwise asquire and dispose of water and water rights, reservoirs, canals, ditches, etc.; generate electricity and operate an electric plant, operate electric or steam railroads, build, construct, maintain, and operate a pipe line or pipe lines within the limits of the counties of Eingham and Fremont, and engage in business, manufacturing, and mercentile pursuits.

#### ARTICUR III.

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be the Town of Elackfoot, in Bingham County, State of Idaho.

#### ARTICLE 1.

#### ARTICER II.

That the purposes for which it is formed are to produce, manufacture, refine, buy, sell, and deal in sugars and syrups; to contract, buy, sell, lease, mortgage, and operate sugar factories, and to carry on all industries incident to the operation of sugar factories; to buy, sell, own, contract, lease, and mortgage real estate; to deal in live stock; own shares of stock in other corporations; buy, sell, lease, and otherwise acquire and dispose of water and water rights, reservoirs, canals, ditches, etc.; generate electricity and operate an electric plant, operate electric or steam railroads, build, construct, maintain, and operate a pipe line or pipe lines within the limits of the Counties of Einghan and Fremont, and engage in business, manufacturing, and mercantile pursuits.
