ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

BURL C. LANGE, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That, we, the undersigned, BURL C. LANGE, THAICE LANGE, and MIKE DINKEL, each being a natural person of full age, and a citizen of the United States of America, have voluntarily and do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify, declare and adopt the following articles of incorporation.

I.

The name of this corporation shall be BURL C. LANGE, INC.

II.

The period of existence and duration of the life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

III.

The location of the registered office of this corporation shall be Kamiah, Idaho, County of Idaho, and the address of the registered office of this corporation shall be Kamiah, Idaho.

IV.

The nature of the business and the objects and purposes of this corporation shall be:

To engage in a general lumber, timber, kiln drying, milling, construction materials, and merchandise business; to manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, sell, or otherwise dispose of logs, lumber, wood products in a processed or unprocessed state, and by-products of wood or of said manufacturing operations, and building and construction supplies and merchandise, either at wholesale or retail.

To engage in the primary business of hauling and transporting logs, timber, lumber, lumber products, and other freight, goods, wares, and merchandise, for itself, or for others, for hire,

1 or otherwise by means of trucks, trailers, and other forms of
2 automotive or other equipment, over public or private highways,
3 or roads; and to do such other things as are incidental, or nec-
4 essary, to the carrying on of such business.

5 To carry on and conduct a general road and highway con-
6 struction business including the designing, constructing, enlarging,
7 extending, repairing, completing, removing, maintaining, redoing,
8 and otherwise engaging in any work upon any highway, road, or barrow
9 pit, and all kinds of excavation and earth construction and instal-
10 lations to make, execute, and to take or receive and contracts
11 which are related thereto, or otherwise connected therewith and to
12 produce, construct, adapt, prepare, deal in, and deal with any
13 materials, articles, or things incidental to or required for and
14 useful in connection with its business and generally to carry on any
15 other business which can advantageously be carried on in conjunction
16 with such heavy or light road, highway and earth moving construction.

17 To purchase real estate, make and purchase materials for
18 the construction of buildings; to erect buildings; to own, manage,
19 operate, lease and sell buildings, to conduct and carry on the
20 business of builders and contractors for the purpose of building,
21 erecting, altering, repairing or doing any other work in connection
22 with any and all classes of buildings, structures, and improvements,
23 of every kind and nature whatsoever; also, to buy or otherwise ac-
24 quire real estate, and to subdivide, plat and sell the same, and
25 generally to buy, sell, and deal in real and personal property of
26 every kind and description, and to own, hold, improve, develop and
27 manage any real estate or personal property and to erect and cause
28 to be erected on any lands owned, held or occupied by the corporation
29 buildings or other structures with their appertenances and to
30 mortgage, sell, lease or otherwise dispose of any lands or interests
31 in lands and in any buildings or other structures at any time owned
32 or held by the corporation; to conduct a general brokerage, agency,

1 and commission business for others in the purchase, sale and manage-
2 ment of real estate for others and the negotiation of loans thereon;
3 in general, to conduct a general building and construction business
4 and a general real estate business.

5 To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, hold, own,
6 sell, assign, transfer, lease, exchange, invest in, mortgage, pledge,
7 or otherwise encumber or dispose of and generally deal and trade in
8 and with, both within and without the State of Idaho, and in any
9 part of the world, goods, wares, merchandise, and property of every
10 kind, nature, and description.

11 To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind and
12 description with any person, firm, association or corporation,
13 municipality, body politics, county, territory, state, government
14 or colony or dependency thereof.

15 To acquire, and to make payment thereafter in cash or the
16 stock or bonds of the corporation, or by undertaking or assuming the
17 obligations and liabilities of the transferror, or in any other way,
18 the good will, rights and property, the whole or any part of the
19 assets, tangible, or intangible, and to undertake or assume the
20 liabilities of, any person, firm, association or corporation, to hold
21 or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the property so
22 purchased; to conduct in any lawful manner the whole or any part of
23 the business so acquired and to exercise all of the powers necessary
24 or convenient for the conduct and management thereof.

25 To adopt, apply for, obtain, register, produce, take
26 purchase, exchange, lease, hire, acquire, secure, own, hold, use,
27 operate, contract, or negotiate for, take licenses or other rights
28 in respect of, sell, transfer, grant licenses and rights in respect
29 of, manufacture under, introduce, sell, assign, collect the royalties
30 on, mortgage, pledge, create liens upon, or otherwise dispose of,
31 deal in, and turn to account, letters patent, patent, patent rights,
32 patents applied for or to be applied for, trade-marks, trade names,

1 and symbols, distinctive marks and indications of origin or owner-
2 ship, copyrights, syndicate rights, inventions, discovery, devices,
3 machines, improvements, licenses, processor, date, and formulas of
4 any and all kinds granted by, or recognized under or pursuant to the
5 laws of the United States of America, or of any other country or
6 countries whatsoever, and with a view to the working and developments
7 of the same, to carry on any business, whether manufacturing or
8 otherwise, which the corporation may think calculated, directly or
9 indirectly, to effectuate these objects.

10 To underwrite, subscribe for, purchase, invest in, or rein-
11 vest, acquire, hold, pledge, hypothecate, exchange, sell, deal in
12 and dispose of, alone or in syndicates or otherwise in conjunction
13 with others, stocks, bonds, debentures, mortgages and other evidences
14 of indebtedness and obligations of any corporation, association,
15 partnership, syndicate, entity, person or governmental, municipal
16 of public authority, comestic or foreign, and evidences of any
17 interest, in respect of any such stocks, bonds and other evidences
18 of indebtedness and obligations; to issue in exchangetherefore its
19 own stocks, bonds or other obligations, and, while the owner or
20 holder of any such, to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges
21 of ownership in respect thereof, and, to the extent now or hereafter
22 permitted by law, to aid by loan, subsidy, guaranty or otherwise
23 those issuing, creating or responsible for any such stocks, bonds
24 or other evidences of indebtedness or obligations or evidences of
25 of any interest in respect thereof.

26 To borrow or raise money for any of the purposes of the
27 corporation, without limit as to the amount, and in connection
28 therewith, to grant collateral or other security either alone or
29 jointly with any other person, firm, or corporation, and to make,
30 execute, draw, accept, endorse, discount, pledge, issue, sell, or
31 otherwise dispose of promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange,
32 warrants, bonds, debentures and other evidences of indebtedness,

1 negotiable or non-negotiable, transferable or non-transferable, and
2 to confer upon the holders of any of its obligations such powers,
3 rights and privileges as from time to time may be deemed advisable
4 by the Board of Directors, to the extent permitted under the General
5 Corporation Law of the State of Idaho; to lend and advance money,
6 extend credit, take notes, open accounts and every kind and nature
7 of evidence of indebtedness and collateral security in connection
8 therewith.

9 To purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, sell, pledge,
10 transfer or otherwise dispose of shares of its own capital stock,
11 provided that the funds or property of the corporation shall not be
12 used for the purchase of its own shares of capital stock when such
13 use would cause any impairment of the capital of the corporation,
14 and provided further, that shares of its own capital stock belonging
15 to the corporation shall not be voted upon directly or indirectly.

16 To have one or more offices, to carry on all or any of its
17 operations and business and without restriction or limit as to
18 amount; to purchase, or otherwise acquire, to hold, own, mortgage,
19 sell, convey or otherwise dispose of real and personal property of
20 every class and description in any of the states, districts,
21 territories, dependencies, possessions or colonies of the United
22 States.

23 IN GENERAL, to do any or all of the things herein set forth
24 to the same extent as natural persons might or could do and in any
25 part of the world, as principals, agents, contractors, trustees, or
26 otherwise, within or without the State of Idaho, either alone or in
27 company with others, and to carry on any other business in connection
28 therewith, and to do all things not forbidden, and with all the powers
29 conferred upon corporations by the laws of the State of Idaho.

30 It is the intention that each of the objects, purposes and
31 powers specified in each of the paragraphs of this Fourth Article of
32 this Certificate of Incorporation shall, except where otherwise

1 specified, be nowise limited or restricted by reference to or in-
2 ference from the terms of any other paragraph or of any other
3 Article in this Certificate of Incorporation, but that the objects
4 purposes and powers specified in this Article and in each of the
5 Articles or paragraphs of this Certificate shall be regarded as
6 independent objects, purposes and powers, and the enumeration of
7 specific purposes and powers shall not be construed to restrict in
8 any manner the general terms and powers of this corporation, nor
9 shall the expression of one thing be deemed to exclude another,
10 although it be of like nature. The enumeration of objects or
11 purposes herein shall not be deemed to exclude or in any way limit
12 by inference any powers, objects, or purposes which this corporation
13 is empowered to exercise, whether expressly by force of the laws of
14 the State of Idaho, now or hereafter in effect, or impliedly by any
15 reasonable construction of said Law.

16 V.

17 In furtherance, and not in limitation of the powers con-
18 ferred by statute, the Board of Directors is expressly authorized:

19 To make and alter by-laws of this corporation, to fix the
20 amount to be reserved as working capital over and above its capital
21 stock paid in, and to authorize and cause to be executed mortgages
22 and liens upon the real and personal property of this corporation.

23 If the by-laws so provide, to designate two or more of its
24 members to constitute an executive committee, which committee shall
25 for the time being, as provided in said resolution or in the by-laws
26 of this corporation, have and exercise any or all of the powers of
27 the Board of Directors in the management of the business and affairs
28 of this corporation, and have power to authorize the seal of this
29 corporation, and have power to authorize the seal of this corporation
30 to be affixed to all papers which may require it.

31 Pursuant to the affirmative vote of the holders of at least
32 a majority of the stock issued and outstanding, having voting powers,

1 given at a stockholders' meeting duly called for that purpose, or
2 when authorized by the written consent of at least a majority of the
3 holders of the voting stock issued and outstanding, the Board of
4 Directors shall have power and authority at any meeting to sell,
5 lease or exchange all of the property and assets of this corporation
6 including its good will and its corporate franchises, upon such
7 terms and conditions as its Board of Directors deems expedient and
8 for the best interest of the corporation.

9 This corporation may in its by-laws confer powers upon its
10 directors in addition to the foregoing, and in addition to the powers
11 and authorities expressly conferred upon them by statute.

12 VI.

13 The capital stock of this corporation shall be TWENTY-FIVE
14 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000), divided into two thousand five hundred
15 shares (2,500) of stock of the par value of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00)
16 each. No distinction shall exist between the shares of this cor-
17 poration and all such shares shall have the same rights in the
18 corporation.

19 VII.

20 All or any portion of the capital stock may be issued for
21 cash or in payment for real or personal property, services, or any
22 other right or thing of value, for the uses and purposes of the
23 corporation, and when so issued shall become and be fully paid, the
24 same as though paid for in cash at par; and the directors shall be
25 the sole judges of the value of any property, right or thing acquired
26 in exchanges for capital stock.

27 VIII.

28 From time to time the capital stock may be increased
29 according to law, and may be issued in such amounts and proportions
30 as shall be determined by the Board of Directors, and as may be
31 permitted by law.


