ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION SECRETARY OF STATE 11 09

IDAHO PHARMACY SERVICES NETWORK, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Law, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be IDAHO PHARMACY SERVICES NETWORK, INC.

ARTICLE II

The IDAHO PHARMACY SERVICES NETWORK, INC. shall be a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE III

The period of its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The purposes of this corporation shall be:

1. To establish, maintain and operate within the State of Idaho a nonprofit pharmaceutical service plan, whereby pharmaceutical services are provided to any person who has, as an individual or as a member of a group, become a subscriber to such pharmaceutical service plan under a contract with this corporation. The corporation shall have the right to enter into contracts with pharmacists and pharmacies whereby it shall compensate them, as provided therein, for pharmaceutical services to such subscribers.

2. To contract with insurance companies and third-party providers of pharmaceutical benefits to employment packages.

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- 3. To promote, develop and encourage the study of means by which pharmaceutical services of all kinds can be distributed to the public at a reasonable cost, consistent with high standards of care and ethical conduct; to process claims and data; provide drug utilization review; and patient-physician drug counseling.
- 4. Any other service allowed to be provided by a nonprofit corporation under the laws of Idaho and not inconsistent with the above stated purposes.

ARTICLE V

The corporation shall have members.

ARTICLE VI

The corporation shall be managed by a board of directors selected from three categories and in the following manner:

- 1. Four (4) board members selected by The IDAHO STATE PHARMACEUTICAL ASSOCIATION (ISPA).
- 2. Two (2) board members elected by general membership of ISPA, one representing single-site pharmacies and one representing multi-site pharmacies.

ARTICLE VII

The corporation shall not have or issue shares of stock, and no dividends shall be paid, and no part of the income or profit

of the corporation shall be distributed to its members, directors or officers; provided, however, that reasonable compensation may be paid for any services rendered to, and reimbursement may be made for any expenses incurred for, the corporation by any officer, director, member, agent, or employee, or any other person or corporation, pursuant to and upon authorization by the board of directors, and provided further that the corporation may make payments to or for the benefit of its members as part of a plan of pharmaceutical services; and provided further that in the event of dissolution of the corporation, the capital contributions of the members, if any, may be returned to the contributors, and all other assets of the corporation shall be distributed as designated by the board of directors, subject to the provisions of the Idaho Nonprofit Corporations Laws.

ARTICLE VIII
