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**Article 2:**

The Corporation is a religious and educational organization organized and operated exclusively for the following purposes as may qualify it for exemption from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provisions of any future United States internal revenue law (the "Code"), and the Treasury Regulations promulgated thereunder (the "Regulations").

The primary purpose of the Corporation shall include:

1. To promote the cause of Christianity and good will.
2. To promote unity among Christians and the love of God throughout the world
3. To promote the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the teachings of the Old and New Testament for the intellectual, moral, and spiritual development and improvement of humankind.

**Article 8:**

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, which is organized and operated exclusively for tax exempt purposes which are reasonably related to the purposes and goals of this Corporation, as may be determined by the Board of Directors of the Corporation in its sole discretion, and which has established its tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization(s), as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes. No director or officer of the Corporation, or any private individual, shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any assets of the Corporation upon the dissolution or complete liquidation of the Corporation.
