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The undersigned incorporator, desiring to form a corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE ONE: The name of the corporation is:

DISTINCTIVE WOOD FLOORS, INC.

ARTICLE TWO: The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE THREE: The purpose of the corporation is to engage in the business of wholesales and retail sales of flooring & installation of wood flooring, and in any and all other lawful business for which a corporation may be organized under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

ARTICLE FOUR: The total number of authorized shares that the corporation shall have is TEN THOUSAND (10,000), which shares shall be without par value.

ARTICLE FIVE: There is no provision for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, and there is no provision for denying preemptive right to the shareholders.

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ARTICLE SIX: The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation and the name of its initial registered agent at that office are:



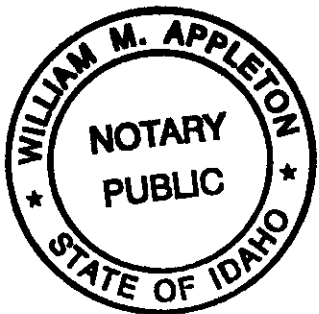
