CORPORATION REINSTATEMENT CERTIFICATE

I, IRA H. MASTERS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State and collector of the annual corporation tax, do hereby certify that

CLEARWATER POWER COMPANY

a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, with its principal place of business in Idaho located at Lewiston, Idaho, forfeited on the 30th day of November, 1955, its charter or authority to do business in the State of Idaho, because of failure to file an annual statement due the State of Idaho for the fiscal year ending June 30th, 1956, as provided by Section 30-608, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the said corporation has subsequently and on the 17th day of January, 1956, filed an annual statement and paid accrued fees and penalties and the said corporation is therefore reinstated on the records of this office, and all the corporate rights which it enjoyed under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Idaho prior to the date of said forfeiture, are hereby restored.
