## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

# OF THE

## REGV ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the United States of America, and a majority of whom are bena fide citizens of the state of Idahe, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the state of Idahe, and we hereby certify, to wit:

ī.

That the name of this corporation shall be, "The Trans-Continental Silver & Copper Mining Company, Limited."

TT.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are to purchase, acquire, ewn, enter and lease mines, mining claims and mineral lands of every kind, nature and description, also to purchase, acquire, enter, ewn or lease mill site, water rights, timber claims, or other timber lands, real estate, terminal facilities, or other easements, to work, prespect and develop mines and mineral lands of every kind, nature or description, either for itself, or for other corporations, companies or individuals, upon such terms and for such remuneration as it shall deem fit and proper, and to accept, take and held mining flaims and lands of every kind, nature and description, either as an entirety, or any interest in the same: and to buy, sell, own, or centrel steak of other corporations as it may deem fit and proper. To do every thing that may be proper in the conduct of its business in the way of developing, prespecting, locating, acquiring, buying, and selling mineral lands and mining elaims of every kind, nature and description, and working such mines and extracting ores and minerals therefrom, and in

reducing such cres to the highest merchantable value and in so deing the same to centraet, buy, build and sell, own and operate all necessary mills, smelters, machinery, roads, railreads, either steam or electric, tramways, ditches, flumes and such other property as it shall deem fit and necessary for carrying out the objects herein stated. To buy, sell, or lease mines and mining preperty of every kind, nature and description, useful or necessary in operating and maintaining the same and in reducing the eres and refining the minerals extraced therefrom. To erect buildinds, saw mills, boarding houses and hotels and to conduct the same. And to conduct mercantile business of all kinds and all other adjuncts pertaining to mining, engineering and concentrating mills; and to engage in read building and the transportation of all things and articles necessary for the maintaining of a mining and milling industry.

#### VIII.

To do and perform all other things that may be found necessary and convenient to earry out the objects of this corporation.

#### IX.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be at Wallace, Sheshene County, State of Idahe with power to establish branch effices elsewhere in the United States of America or the Demimien of Canada at such places as said corporation, or the beard of Directors may direct.
