



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
~~THUNDER MOUNTAIN CHICAGO GOLD MINING COMPANY.~~

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily ~~agreed~~ ~~entered into a written agreement~~ for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, and we hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I.

The name of this Corporation shall be the Thunder Mountain Chico Gold Mining Company.

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which this Corporation is formed are to work, operate, buy, sell, lease, locate, acquire, procure, hold and deal in mines, metals and mineral claims of every description and kind, within the United States of America and elsewhere; to acquire, own and operate mills or reduction works for milling or treating gold, silver, copper or other minerals, to carry on a general mining, smelting and reduction business; to purchase, acquire, hold, erect and operate electric light and power plants for the purpose of mining and treating ores, and for the purpose of furnishing lights and creating power for all purposes; to bond, buy, lease, locate and hold ditches, flumes and water rights; to construct, lease, buy, sell, build or operate railroads, ferries, surface or cable tramways, or other means of transportation for the purpose of carrying, conveying or transporting ores, mining or other material, or passengers, or the products of such mines, mills and reduction works; to own, bond, buy, sell, lease and locate timber and timber claims; and finally, to do everything consistent, proper and requisite, in their fullest and broadest sense, within the territory aforesaid.

ARTICLE III.

The place where the principal business of said corporation shall be carried on shall be in the City of Spokane, Spokane County, Washington.

ARTICLE IV.

The term for which this corporation shall exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation.
