THE UNDERSIGNED, who is duly licensed as a doctor of osteopathy in the State of Idaho, as incorporator, desires to form a professional corporation for the purpose of providing medical services, and hereby adopts the following articles of incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE 1: NAME

The name of the corporation is DAVID J. BARCLAY, P.C.

ARTICLE 2: PURPOSES AND POWERS

The purpose for which the corporation is formed is to engage in the general practice of medicine. In connection therewith, the corporation shall have the power and authority to do all acts not expressly prohibited by Chapter 13 of Title 30 of the Idaho Code and any other applicable law.

ARTICLE 3: DURATION

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE 4: STOCK

Only individuals who are licensed physicians in the State of Idaho shall be authorized to own stock in the corporation.

ARTICLE 5: PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The office of the corporation shall be located at 119 North Wardwell, Emmett, Gem County, Idaho.

ARTICLE 6: INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 119 North Wardwell, Emmett, Gem County, Idaho, and the name of the initial registered agent at such address is DAVID J. BARCLAY.

IDAHO SECRETARY OF STATE

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ARTICLE 7: DIRECTORS

The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors of the corporation is one, and the name and address of the person who is to serve as director until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until his successor is elected and shall qualify is: DAVID J. BARCLAY, 2281 Tanglewood, Emmett, Idaho 83617. Only individuals who are licensed physicians in the State of Idaho shall serve as a director in the corporation.

ARTICLE 8: INCORPORATOR

The name and address of the incorporator of the corporation is DAVID J. BARCLAY, 2291 Tanglewood, Emmett, Idaho 83617.

ARTICLE 8: CAPITALIZATION

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is one hundred thousand (100,000) shares of common stock, with a par value of ten dollars (\$10.00) each for a total capitalization of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00). All of said stock shall be of one class and shall be common stock.
