ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

TRI-STATE CEDAR, INC.

An Idaho Corporation

WILLIAM W. EIVYANT, ROBERT D. PFIESTER, ROBERT W. O'CONNELL and EDWARD L. HOWARD, all electors of Benewah County, Idaho, and citizens of the United States, associate as an Idaho Corporation, under the General Business Corporation Code of the State of Idaho, as follows:

I.

NAME: The name of this corporation shall be Tri-State Cedar, Inc., an Idaho Corporation.

II.

BUSINESS LOCATION: The principal place of business and post office address of this corporation shall be at St. Maries, Benewah County, Idaho.

III.

PURPOSES AND POWERS: This corporation shall have all of the powers vested in an Idaho Corporation by the General Business Corporation Code of the State of Idaho and the powers herein enumerated, and is organized and shall be operated for the purpose of acquiring, holding, disposing of, and/or encumbering real and/or personal property, and particularly timber and timber lands and

firm product, as well as mineral oil refined from the
