KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE FRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, all being full-age citizens and residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated curselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

AME

The name of this corporation shall be Wan Lee's of Wash., Inc.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES

The purposes for which this corporation is to be formed are:

- (a) Frimarily, to purchase, and sell notions, toys, hardware, electrical supplies, department store supplies and merchandise of every kind, and to generally engage in the operation of a variety store.
- (b) To make and perform contracts of any kind and description in corrying on its business, or for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its objects. To borrow or raise memby for any of the purposes of the corporation. To buy or sell notes, cortgages, or other evidences of debt, including notes and mortgages of this corporation. To own, buy and sell real and personal property. To mortsare, hypothecate or otherwise encumber any of said property. To endorse, guarantee and secure the payment and satisfaction of bonds, coupons, mortgages, debentures, obligations, and evidence of indebtedness, and to do any and all other acts and things, and to exercise any and all other powers which a co-partnership or natural person could do and exercise, and which now or hereafter be authorized by law. To have offices, conduct its business, and promote its objects within and without the State of Idaho, without restriction as to place or amount, and this corporation shall have the power to held be estings within or without the State of Idaho, as may be determined from time

- (c) To eagage in any commercial, industrial, and agricultural enterprise calculated or designed to be profitable to this comporation and in conformity with the laws of the State of Idaho; to generally engage in, do and perform, any enterprise, act, or vocation that a natural person might or could do or perform; to engage in the manufacture, sale, purchase, importing, and exporting of merchandise and personal property of all manner and description, to act as agents for the purchase, sale, and handling of goods, wares, and merchandise of any and all types and descriptions for the account of the corporation or as factor, agent, procurer, or otherwise for or on behalf of another.
- (d) The purposes specified herein shall be do strued both as purposes and powers and shall be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause in this or any other article, but the purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses herein shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers, and the engageration of specific purposes and powers shall not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner the meaning of general terms or of the general powers of the corporation; nor shall be expression of one ting be deemed to exclude another, although it be of like nature not expressed.
