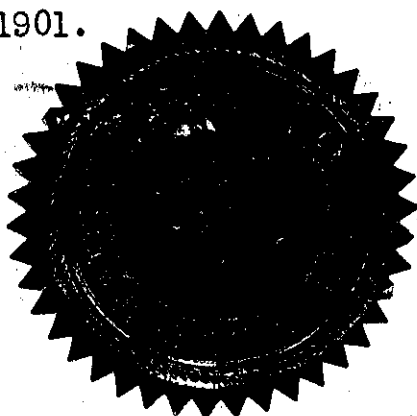

The undersigned, agrees to become a corporation by the name of

BLUE JACKET CONSOLIDATED COPPER CO.,

for the purpose of taking, owning, holding, developing and operating mines, mineral lands and mineral property, especially in the State of Idaho, United States of America; and of taking, owning and holding every thing necessary and useful for mining and the operation and development of mines, mineral lands and mineral property of every kind and description, including gravel and placer mines; and of mining, smelting, reducing or otherwise treating ores, refining, milling, dredging and sluicing gold, silver and other minerals and mineral products, and purchasing and selling the same and the products thereof.
