## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## ONEIDA FAIR BOARD CONCESSIONS, INC.

A Nonprofit Corporation

SECRETARY OF STATE

we, the undersigned natural persons of the age of 18 years or more, acting as incorporators for the purpose of creating a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, as contained in Title 30, Chapter 301 et sec of the Idaho Code of the State of Idaho, entitled "Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act," and the several amendments thereto, do hereby set forth:

- 1. Name. The name of the Corporation is the ONEIDA FAIR BOARD CONCESSIONS, INC.
- 2. Duration. The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.
- 3. Purpose. The purpose of this corporation is to promote, manage, sponsor, supervise, and facilitate the concessions for the annual Oneida County Fair and Horse Races and the Oneida County Rodeo and all related functions, activities and properties real and personal, incidental thereto and all such activities as are normally associated with the operations and functioning of county fair and rodeo concessions.
  - 4. Membership corporation. The Corporation will be a

membership corporation, the terms of which shall be governed in the Bylaws.

- 5. Election of Directors. Directors of the Corporation shall be elected in the manner provided in Bylaws of the Corporation.
- 6. Address. The address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is as follows:

The name of the initial registered agent of the Corporation at the above address is ALBERT EKSTROM.

- 9. Powers. The Corporation shall have all the powers granted corporations under the laws of the State of Idaho. However, notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the Corporation shall exercise only such powers as are in furtherance of the exempt purposes of organizations set forth in the subsection of Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 under which the Corporation chooses to qualify for exemption, as the same now exists, or as it may be amended from time to time.
  - 10. Distribution or dissolution. In the event of the dissolution of the Association, no member shall be entitled to any distribution or division of its remaining property or its proceeds, and the balance of all money and other property received by the Association from any source, after the payment of all debts and obligations of the Association, shall be used or distributed exclusively for purposes within the intendment of

Section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code as the same now exists or as it may be amended from time to time.
