## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF AQUABILITY, INC.



The undersigned, acting as an incorporator under the provisions of the I laho Nonprofit Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

- 1. <u>Name</u>. The name of this Corporation is AquAbility, Inc.
- 2. <u>Nonprofit Corporation</u>. This Corporation is a nonprofit corporal on and is not organized for the pecuniary benefit of any of its members, officers or directors. No part of the assets, income or profit of the Corporation shall be distributable to, or inure to the benefit of, its members, officers or directors, except to the extent permitted under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act.
  - 3. <u>Period of Duration</u>. The duration of this Corporation is to be perpetual.
  - 4. <u>Purposes and Powers</u>.
- 4.1 <u>Purposes</u>. The purposes for which this Corporation is or anized are for scientific, educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 5(1(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, now in effect or as may be amended hereafter, and in this regard, to provide for and enhance the physical, intellectual and emotional well-being of challenged or disabled individuals through the sport of swimming.
- 4.2 <u>Powers</u>. This Corporation shall have all the powers, eith r directly or indirectly, to do any and all lawful acts and to engage in any and all lawful acts ities which may be necessary, desirable or proper for the furtherance and accomplishment of any or all of the purposes for which the Corporation is organized. Notwithstanding anything to he contrary, the Corporation shall exercise only such powers as are in furtherance of the exempt purposes of an organization set forth in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, now in effect or as may be amended hereafter.
  - 5. <u>Membership</u>. This Corporation shall have members.
- 6. Registered Office and Registered Agent. The address and post of fice box of the registered office of this Corporation are 191 Fifth Street West, Suite B-2, Ketch im, Idaho 83340 and Post Office Box 610, Ketchum, Idaho 83340. The name of the initial registered agent of this Corporation at that address is Karen A. Morrison.
- 7. <u>Directors</u>. The number of Directors shall be as specified in the F ylaws of this Corporation and such number may from time to time be increased or decreased in such manner as

8. <u>Incorporator</u>. The name and address of the incorporator of this (orporation is Thomas C. Praggastis, P. O. Box 6090, 191 Fifth Street West, Ketchum, Idaho 3340.

- 9. <u>Provisions for Regulation of Corporation's Internal Affairs.</u>
- 9.1 <u>Meetings of Members and Directors</u>. Meetings of the Mombers and Directors of this Corporation may be held either within or without the State of I laho at such place or places as may from time to time be designated in the Bylaws or by rescution of the Board of Directors.
- 9.2 <u>Bylaws</u>. The initial Bylaws of this Corporation shall be a dopted by its Board of Directors. The power to amend or repeal the Bylaws or to adopt new Bylaws shall be in the Directors, as set forth in the Bylaws. The Bylaws may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of this Corporation which are consistent with the Ic aho Nonprofit Corporation Act and these Articles of Incorporation.
- 9.3 <u>Compensation of Directors</u>. The Board of Directors shal not receive compensation for their services as directors. A Director may serve the Corporation in any other capacity and may receive compensation therefrom in any form.
- 9.4 Contracts in Which Directors Have an Interest. The Byla ws of the Corporation shall provide for the handling of contracts or transactions in which Directors may have a financial interest, whether direct or indirect.
- 9.5 <u>Indemnification of Directors and Officers</u>. The Bylaws of the Corporation shall provide for the circumstances in which Directors and officers of the Corporation may be entitled to indemnification.

- Prohibited Activities. No part of the activities of the Corporatio shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or participating in or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campai an on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 11. Distribution on Dissolution. Upon the dissolution or other termination of the Corporation, no part of the property of the Corporation or any of the proceeds s tall be distributed to or inure to the benefit of any of the members, directors or officers of the Cor oration, but all such property and proceeds, subject to the discharge of valid obligations of the Corporation and to the applicable provisions of the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, shall be di tributed to such organizations as shall qualify under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue (ode, now in effect or as may be amended hereafter.
