ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation without capital stock under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do herey certify:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be SOUTHCENTRAL IDAHO
CENTENNIAL CORPORATION.

ARTICLE II

The purposes and objects for which such corporation is formed are as follows:

- a. To formulate and carry out educational, patriotic and historical plans and purposes for celebrating the One Hundredth Anniversary of the establishment of the territory of the State of Idaho
- b. To gather and disseminate information concerning the establishment, history and growth of the State of Idaho and to arrange, carry out educational programs, pageants, theatrical and other entertainments of educational, patriotic and historical interest to the citizens of the City of Burley, State of Idaho, in relation thereto.
- c. To solicit, collect and otherwise raise money for said purposes and to expend, contribute, disburse and otherwise handle and dispose of the same for said purposes and to do any and all other things necessary or proper in connection with or incidental to any of the foregoing purposes; but said corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit.

d. To borrow money and from time to time, to make, accept, endorse, execute and issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes, bills of exchange and other obligations of the corporation for monies borrowed or in payment of property acquired or for any of the other objects or purposes of the corporation or its business and to secure the payment of any such obligations by mortgage, pledge, deed, indenture, agreement or other instrument of trust, or by other lien upon assignment or agreement in regard to all or any part of the property, rights or privileges of the corporation wherever situated, whether now owned or hereafter to be acquired; and to acquire and sell real estate for any of its purposes.

ARTICLE III

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV

The location and Post Office address of this corporation shall be the City Hall, Burley, Cassia County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V

This corporation is a non-profit corporation and shall have no capital stock and shall pay no dividends or salaries to its incorporators, officers or members of the board of directors.

ARTICLE VI

The board of directors of this corporation shall consist of the elected directors, but in no instance shall the number be less than three or more than thirty-five members of the board. The government, membership, and officers, meetings and elections shall be as prescribed

by the by-laws of the said corporation.

ARTICLE VII

Pursuant to a notice published in the Burley Herald, a newspaper published in the City of Burley, County of Cassia, for two weeks and posted at the Chamber of Commerce office in the City Hall, the place of the meeting, for a like period, an election of officers and board of directors of the Southcentral Idaho Centennial Corporation was held on the 15th day of April, 1963, at the Chamber of Commerce office in the City Hall in Burley, Idaho, at the hour of 11:30 A. M. A majority of all members were present at such meeting and voted at such election and the result of such election was as follows:
