

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

OF

THE GENTILE VALLEY LAND AND CATTLE COMPANY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we the undersigned residents of Bannock County, Idaho have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho.

And we do hereby certify:

1st.-

That the name of the corporation is THE GENTILE VALLEY LAND AND CATTLE COMPANY.

Limited

2nd.-

The purposes for which said corporation is formed are to engage in buying, owning, selling, and exchanging land and real estate: acquiring, owning, holding, operating and maintaining water, water rights, dams, ditches, flumes, reservoirs, aqueducts and systems for the use, operation and distribution of water for agricultural purposes and for domestic purposes: raising, breeding, feeding, buying selling and exchanging cattle and other live stock: erecting, buying, owning, operating and selling saw mills and buying, owning, selling and exchanging lumber: buying, selling, exchanging and handling general merchandise: and generally, for the purpose of engaging in all other matters directly or indirectly connected with the foregoing business.

3rd.-

That the place where its principal business is to be transacted shall be Lago, Bannock County, Idaho: that the principal office shall be at said Lago.

4th.-

That the term for which said corporation shall exist is fifty years from and after the date hereof.
