KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

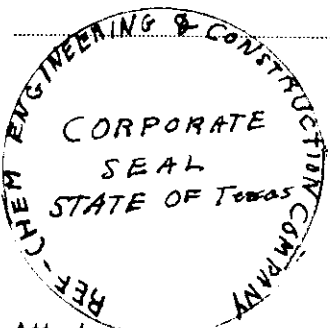
That REF-CHEM ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION COMPANY
