
TWIN BUTTE LIONS CLUB, INCORPORATED,

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
TWIN BUTTES LIONS CLUB, INCORPORATED
SECRETARY OF STATE

I, the undersigned, a natural person of full age, and a citizen of the United States and of the State of Idaho, in order to form a non-profit corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, and all acts amendatory and supplementary thereto, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

I.

The name of this corporation shall be TWIN BUTTES LIONS CLUB, INCORPORATED and shall be a non-profit corporation.

II.

The corporation, when formed, shall have perpetual existence.

III.

The name of the registered agent of the corporation shall be IRA LINDSAY. The location and post office address of the office of the corporation shall be Route 5 Blackfoot, Idaho 83221.

IV.

The purposes and objects of this corporation shall be:

1. To create and foster a spirit of understanding among the people of the world.
2. To promote the principles of good government and good citizenship.
3. To take an active interest in the civic, cultural, social and moral welfare of the community.
4. To unite the clubs in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship and mutual understanding.
5. To provide a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest; provided, however, that partisan politics and sectarian religion shall not be debated by the club member.

6. To encourage service minded men to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavors.
7. Generally to carry out in this area the principles and teachings of The International Association of Lions Clubs, a service club of with which the Twin Buttes Lions Club is affiliated.
8. Except as herein limited, to exercise all powers granted to non-profit corporations by the laws of the State Idaho.
9. To incorporate the unincorporated association known as the Twin Buttes Lions Club.

V.

That the Twin Buttes Lions Club is chartered by, and under the supervision of, The International Association of Lions Club of Oak Brook, Illinois, and is governed by the Constitution and by-laws of said Association.

VI.

This corporation shall have no capital stock and shall not engage in business for profit, but shall be supported by gifts, bequests, benefits, contributions and fees and dues paid by members. Membership in the corporation shall be governed and controlled as provided in the Constitution and By-Laws of this corporation. No part of the earnings, income or receipts of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of or be distributed to any individual, member, or members of this corporation.

VII.

The officers by whom, and the manner in which the objects and purposes of this corporation shall be carried out, shall be as provided by the Constitution and By-Laws of this Corporation.

VIII.
