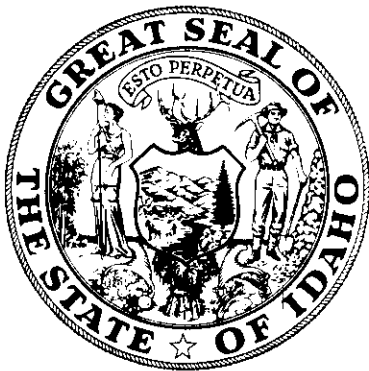

The undersigned, as President and Secretary of Parkinson, Lojek & Penland, Chartered, pursuant to Idaho Code § 30-1-61, do hereby set forth the following Articles of Amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of Parkinson, Lojek & Penland, Chartered, an Idaho corporation as follows:

(a) The name of the corporation is Parkinson, Lojek & Penland, Chartered.

(b) The amendments so adopted are:

an article 8 is hereby added in its entirety to read:

8. Shareholders shall have no preemptive rights to acquire unissued or treasury shares.

(d) The date of the adoption of the amendments by the shareholders was May 10,, 1984.

(d) The number of shares outstanding is 100, and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon is 100.


(e) The number of shares voted for such amendment is 100 and the number of shares voted against such amendment is 0.

(f) The amendment does not provide for exchange, reclassification or cancellation of issued shares.

(g) The amendments do not effect a change in the amount of stated capital.




